

Q1 Do you use Darlington's library service?



Q2 Which of the following Darlington library services do you use? (Please mark all that apply).





Q3 How often do you use the Darlington library services that you marked?



Q4 Which of the following library services do you use when you visit a Darlington library? (Please mark all that apply).





Q9 Which of the following online services do you use via the Darlington Libraries website (www2.darlington.gov.uk)? (Please mark all that apply).





Q11 If the proposal to relocate the town centre Library were to go ahead, which would be the best times for you to visit on a week day? (Please mark all that apply).



Q12 If the proposal to relocate the town centre Library were to go ahead, which would be the best times for you to visit on a Saturday? (Please mark all that apply).



Q13 If you do not currently use the library service, are any of the following the reasons why you do not? (Please mark all that apply).









Q18 Do you consider yourself to have a disability or long term illness?


