

CORE OFFER BUDGET FOR CORONERS

WHY DOES THE COUNCIL HAVE TO PROVIDE THIS SERVICE AND WHAT DOES IT NEED TO COVER?

Coroners

DBC is obliged to pay a percentage of Durham County Council's bill for the Coroners services that serve both Local Authority areas. The cost is not a fixed fee but reflects actual work done and is outside DBC control.

HOW DOES THE CORE OFFER BUDGET MEET THE COUNCIL'S OBLIGATIONS?

The Council is obliged to pay a percentage of the Coroner's service

The payment is not fixed but reflects actual work done on an annual basis.
