PERSON SPECIFICATION FOR PANEL MEMBER

To be eligible for appointment, a person must not be disqualified from holding office as a member of a Local Authority. Selection Criteria

Prospective members should :-

- 1. Have an understanding of Local Government and the broader community issues.
- 2. Have the ability to act impartially.
- 3. Be aged over 18 years.
- 4. Not be a Councillor of any Local Authority (including Town/Parish Councils).
- 5. Not be directly related to, or a close friend of, a Darlington Borough Councillor or an officer of the Council.
- 6. Not be employed by Darlington Borough Council.
- 7. Not be a member of any political party.
- 8. Have good communication skills and the ability to communicate effectively and work with others in order to produce a report and recommendations.
- 9. Be able to analyse information, ask pertinent questions and retain confidentiality.
- 10. Be able to attend meetings during normal office hours.
