The reasons for the differences in health between Darlington residents and the rest of England, and within Darlington, are complex. They can be summarised as:-

- Inequalities in opportunity – poverty, family, education, employment and environment (the wider determinants of health).
- Inequalities in lifestyle choices – smoking, physical activity, food, drugs, alcohol and sexual activity,
- Inequalities in access to service for those who are already ill or have accrued risk factors for disease.

The Health & Well Being Scrutiny Committee's Work Programme is reflective of these three key drivers:

- **(O) – Opportunities**
- **(C) – Choices**
- **(A) – Access**

This work programme has been developed with consideration to three priorities for improvement outlined within the Corporate Plan, i.e.:

- Developing a shared approach to public health;
- Better quality of life for older people in the Community.
