CABINET'S DELEGATED POWERS – ADDITIONAL CAPITAL EXPENDITURE

Purpose of the report

1. To increase Cabinet's delegation to approve additional capital expenditure from £250,000 to £500,000 for the financial year 2005-06.

Background

- 2. Under the Council's Constitution, Part 3 Responsibility for Functions, Cabinet can approve capital schemes, to be financed via the Authority's own resources, up to a cumulative maximum of £250,000 without reference to Council each financial year. To date during 2005/06 Cabinet has approved £246,000 of additional capital expenditure which will be funded from the Council's own resources without reference to Council for a number of schemes outlined in **Appendix 1**.
- 3. In order that capital schemes can progress promptly it is requested that Council increase the maximum limit that Cabinet can approve without reference to Council during 2005-06 by £250,000 to £500,000. If this approval is not given then new schemes cannot be released in the current financial year without Council approval.

Outcome of Consultation

4. There has been no consultation of this report.

Legal Implications

5. This report has been considered by the Borough Solicitor for legal implications in accordance with the Council's approved procedures. There are no issues which the Borough Solicitor considers need to be brought to the specific attention of Members, other than those highlighted in the report.

Section 17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998

6. The contents of this report have been considered in the context of the requirements placed on the Council by Section 17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998, namely, the duty on the Council to exercise its functions with due regard to the likely effect of the exercise of those functions on, and the need to do all that it reasonably can to prevent, crime and disorder in its area. It is not considered that the contents of this report have any such effect.

7. The issues contained within this report do represent a change to Council Policy.

Conclusion

8. It is requested that Council increase the maximum limit of additional capital expenditure that Cabinet approve without reference to Council to £500,000 for the financial year 2005-06.

Recommendation

9. Council is requested to increase the maximum limit of additional capital expenditure that can be approved by Cabinet without reference to Council from £250,000 to £500,000 for the financial year 2005-06.

Reasons

10. The recommendations are supported in order that urgent capital schemes can progress promptly.
