Purpose of Report

1. To consider the appointment of a Member to the Board of Governors of a future County Durham and Darlington Foundation Trust.

Information and Analysis

- 2. County Durham and Darlington Acute Hospitals NHS Trust has applied, and received approval from the Secretary of State, to become a Foundation Trust. The application is now being assessed by Monitor, the independent regulator for Foundation Trusts.
- 3. As part of the new governance arrangements, a Board of Governors is being established comprising of elected staff, public Governors and appointed representatives from key stakeholders. The governance arrangements, outlined in the Trust's integrated business plan included an appointed Governor from this Council. Department of Health guidance requires that the individual nominations be made by the organisations concerned.
- 4. The Governor elections will be completed and the results announced on 18th October, 2006, at which time the Trust will be announcing the full membership of the Board of Governors.

Outcome of Consultation

5. No formal consultation was undertaken on this report.

Legal Implications

6. This report has been considered by the Borough Solicitor for legal implications in accordance with the Council's approved procedures. There are no issues which the Borough Solicitor considers need to be brought to the specific attention of Members, other than those highlighted in the report.
