(URGENT ITEM) HAUGHTON ROAD SITE – UNDERGROUNDING OF OVERHEAD ELECTRICITY CABLES (EXCLUSION NO. 7 AND 9) – Pursuant to Minute C33(8)/Jul/04, the Chief Executive introduced the report of the Director of Development and Environment (previously circulated) requesting that consideration be given to the terms to be negotiated with English Partnership in respect of the proposed joint venture agreement relating to the Council's land at Haughton Road, which would be enhanced as a consequence of overhead electricity cables, which currently cross the site, being undergrounded. A plan showing the overhead cables, which currently cross the site, was appended to the submitted report.
