LA9. LICENSING ACT 2003 SUMMARY OF LICENCES GRANTED 1 OCTOBER 2011 TO 31 OCTOBER 2012 – The Director of Place submitted a report (previously circulated) advising Members of the licences granted in relation to the Licensing Act 2003 for the period of 1st October 2011 to 31 October 2012. The report detailed that Officers have granted 20 uncontested applications of Premises Licences (including 11 variations of licenses) and granted 72 applications to vary the Designated Premise Supervisor, 53 applications to transfer a premises licence, 18 minor variations and 66 Personal Licences. It was also noted that four Premises Licences have been granted following a Hearing by a Sub Committee of the main Committee and two reviews of a Premises Licence have also been heard.

LA10. THE LIVE MUSIC ACT 2012 – The Director of Place submitted a report (previously circulated) informing Members of the enactment of the Live Music Act 2012. The submitted report highlighted that the Live Music Act 2012 has amended section 177 of the Licensing Act 2003, so that the section only applies to dancing, by partially deregulating the performance of live music and removing regulation in respect of the provision of entertainment facilities.
