ENQUIRY GROUP 2

Purpose of Report

1. To gauge Members of the Children and Young People Scrutiny Committee's views on education and skills in Darlington.

Background

- 2. The Local Strategic Partnership (LSP) has established six Enquiry Groups to focus on key areas of development for Darlington, the outcomes of which will refresh the Community Strategy. Each Enquiry Group is chaired by a high profile individual, who is independent of the Council, and each group has a specific question to answer. The questions posed by the LSP for the Enquiry Groups are outlined in **Appendix 1**.
- 3. The Enquiry Groups will be working on these questions and will inform the Sustainable Community Strategy to be in place for 2008. In working on these questions, it is hoped that as many agencies and individuals as possible can be involved and engaged.
- 4. Like all the questions, that given to Enquiry Group 2 is highly aspirational. The aim of the Enquiry Group 2 meetings is to identify a relatively small number of key issues where action and energy can be focused in the future.
