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**DATA QUALITY REVIEWS – MANAGEMENT ARRANGEMENTS AND SPOT CHECKS**

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**Purpose of Report**

1. To present the external audit report on Data Quality.

**Information and Analysis**

2. Attached is a copy of the report produced by PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) following an assessment of the Council's management arrangements relating to data quality. The assessment was completed in accordance with the methodology and guidance issued by the Audit Commission.
3. Representatives from PwC will attend the meeting to present the report.
4. The outcome from the assessment is positive. The report states that, 'The Council's overall management arrangements for ensuring data quality are performing well'. The report highlights a number of strengths in the Council's approach and identifies areas of improvement that are to be addressed by officers.
