# OFSTED INSPECTIONS OF CHILDREN'S HOMES AND SHORT BREAK CENTRE FOR DISABLED CHILDREN - OUTCOMES

### SUMMARY REPORT

#### **Purpose of the Report**

1. The purpose of this report is to inform members of the Children and Young People's Scrutiny Committee of the outcomes of Ofsted inspections of Children's Homes and the Short break Centre for disabled children

#### **Summary**

- 2. Since July 2010 three children's homes and the short break centre have been inspected by Ofsted as part of their ongoing inspections in line with the requirements of the Care Standards Act 2000.
- 3. All the provision was found to be at least satisfactory (a sound provision) with the short break centre being judged as good (a strong provision). Ofsted found areas of strength in every setting.
- 4. Areas which were deemed as requiring action or where recommendations were made have been the subject of focused work with managers and staff in the Children's Homes. Links are in place with other Local authorities for sharing good practice around the inspection process.
- 5. Strategic work is currently taking place regarding the long term future plans for each home
