Litter	Anyone found depositing litter including cigarette ends, chewing gum, etc., on land open to the air, including private land and land covered by water, which they then leave.	Can be set at local level (between £50 to £80), default £75
Street Litter Control Notices and Litter Clearing Notices	A Litter Control Notice can be issued to certain types of retail/commercial premises fronting a street causing a litter problem and covers land that is within 100 metres of the premises, except in the case of automated teller machines, in which case it must be within 10 metres. Litter Clearing Notices can be served on all types of land, private as well as public,	Can be set at local level (between £75 to £110), default £100

Graffiti and fly posting	For minor acts of graffiti and fly posting.	Can be set at a local level (between £50 to £80), default £75
Waste receptacle	Offences cover household, commercial and industrial waste. This is where the individual or organisation does not comply with the local authority's requirements for waste receptacle, collection point and time of collection. (Applies to residents putting refuse out too early for collection).	Can be set at a local level (between £75 to £110), default £100
