
OVERVIEW OF RESOURCES SCRUTINY COMMITTEE

1. Since the last ordinary meeting of Council, the following are the main areas of work the Resources Scrutiny Committee has undertaken :-
 - (a) Work Programme 2007/08** – We have considered our Work Programme and possible Review topics for the Municipal Year 2007/08. We will be continuing to work on the major reviews which we have been undertaking in 2006/07 in relation to Gershon and the Council’s Procurement Strategy and we will also be continuing to look at the position in relation to Community and Voluntary Sector funding. We will obviously also be heavily involved in considering and monitoring the Council’s financial plans as part of our work programme, together with a number of Human Resource issues such as health and safety and sickness absence.
 - (b) Dolphin Centre Refurbishment** – Following a request by a Member, we have also received information in relation to the refurbishment of the Dolphin Centre and the financial management and operation of the Contract. It is pleasing to report that, following the re-opening of the Centre on 16th December, 2006, customer feedback and attendance is both positive and strong.

I, as Chair, have continued to have various meetings with Officers and have pursued a number of issues raised with me, by Members of the Scrutiny Committee, and reported the responses back to them accordingly.
