# MAIN REPORT

### **Information and Analysis**

- 5. Polling places were last reviewed in December 2007 and a further full review will be held later in 2011 to meet the legislative timetable (four-yearly reviews).
- 6. All proposed polling places for the Local Elections and the Referendum on the Voting System for UK Parliamentary Elections have been inspected in an attempt to ensure high levels of voter participation. Access issues and compliance with the Disability Discrimination Act have also been taken into consideration.
- 7. Officers have also been liaising with head teachers in an attempt to keep schools open during the polls. It is the head teacher's decision, after undertaking a risk assessment, as to whether the school should remain open or close. Those schools remaining open on Election Day are detailed in the **Appendix**.

# **Polling Places**

- 8. The venues, in the main, mirror those used for the Parliamentary election in May last year but there are some minor changes suggested. The list in the **Appendix** also shows any changes since the Parliamentary Election in 2010.
- 9. Where changes are suggested, the electorate will be notified of the new venue as part of their pre-poll information (either on the Poll Card or by a separate leaflet notification). When changes have been suggested Ward Members have been consulted.
- 10. Darlington Association on Disability has also been consulted on the proposals and is in agreement with the suggested locations.

# Conclusion

11. This report asks Members to approve the polling places for the local elections and the Referendum on the Voting System for UK Parliamentary Elections scheduled for 5th May, 2011.
