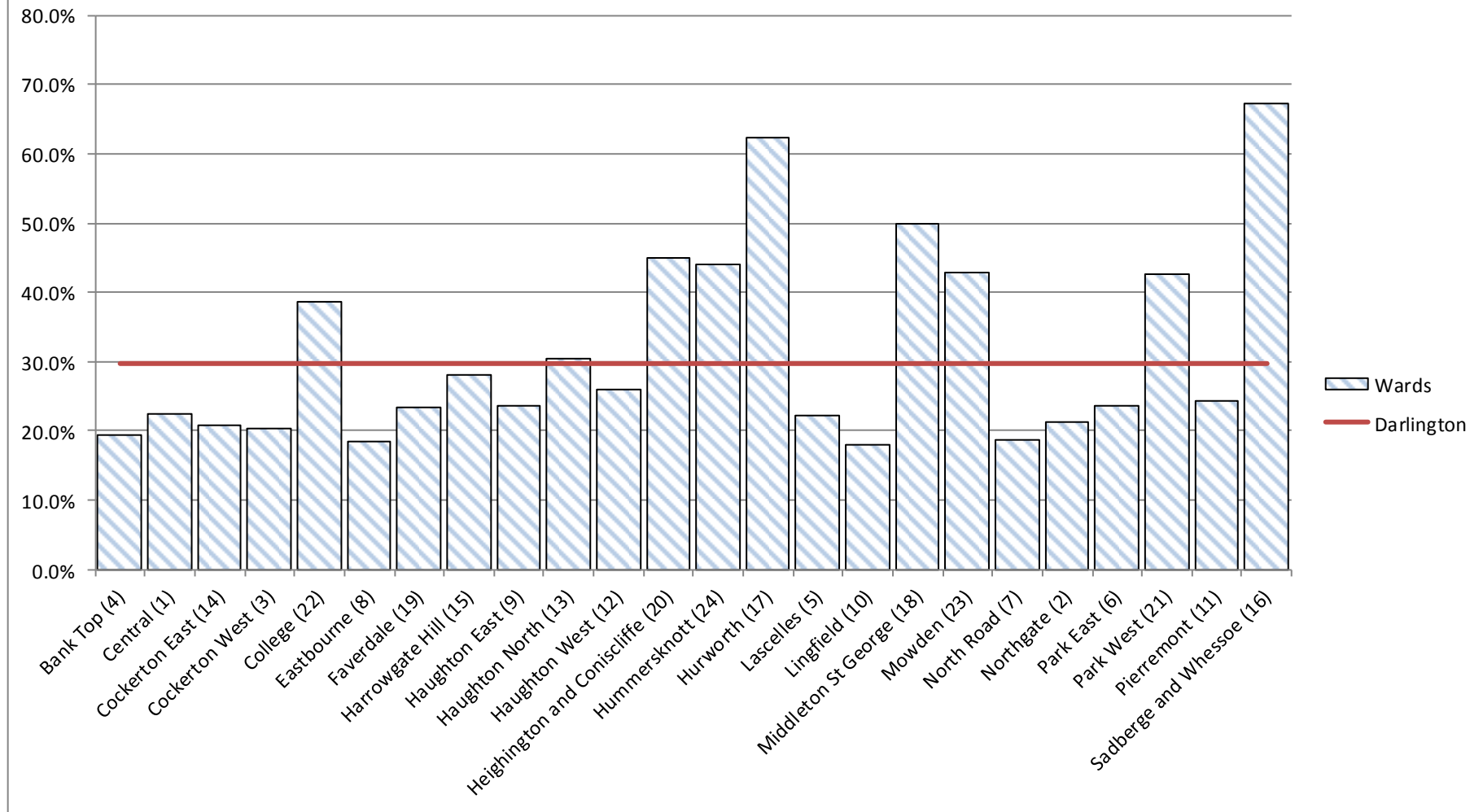

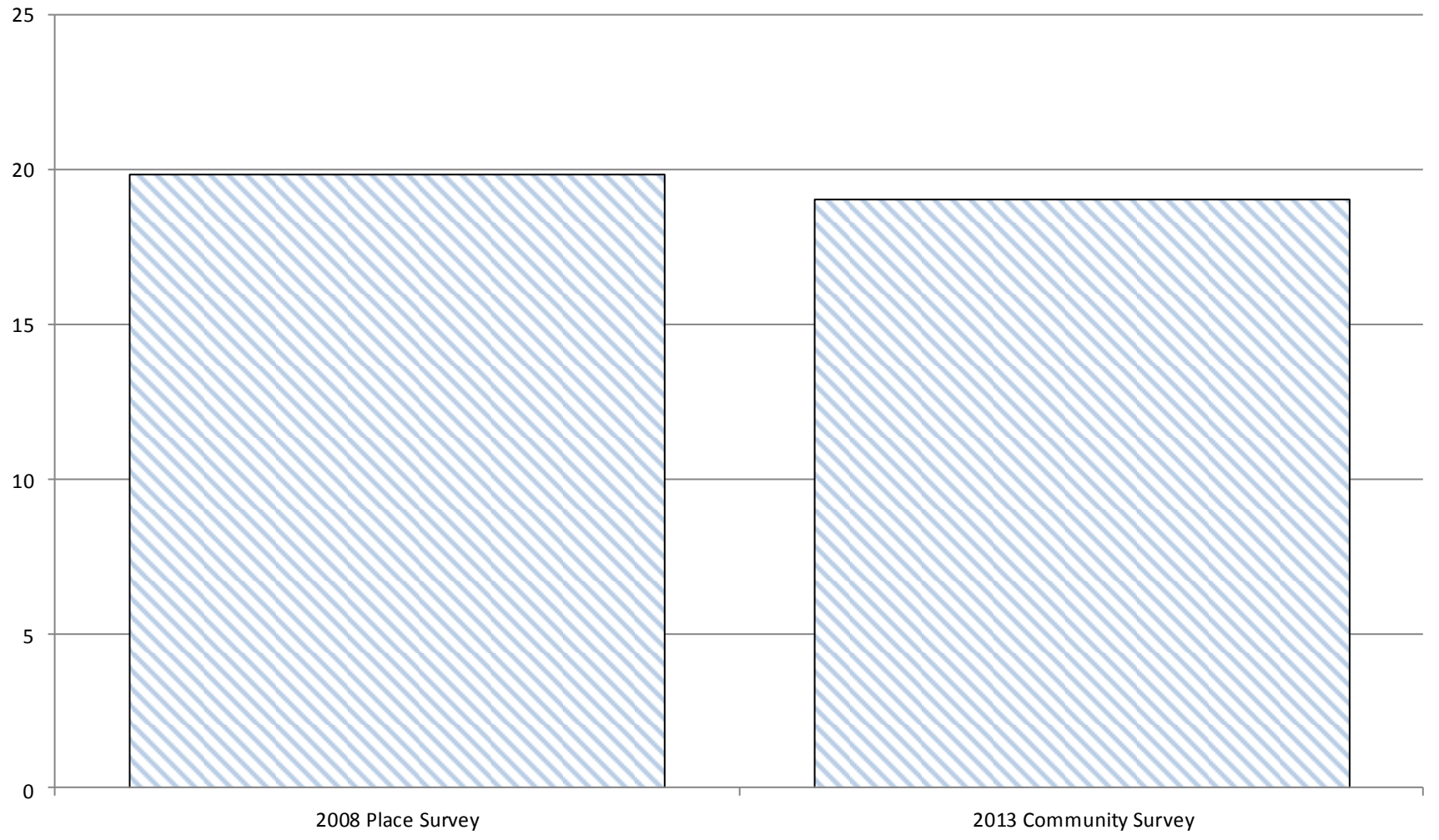

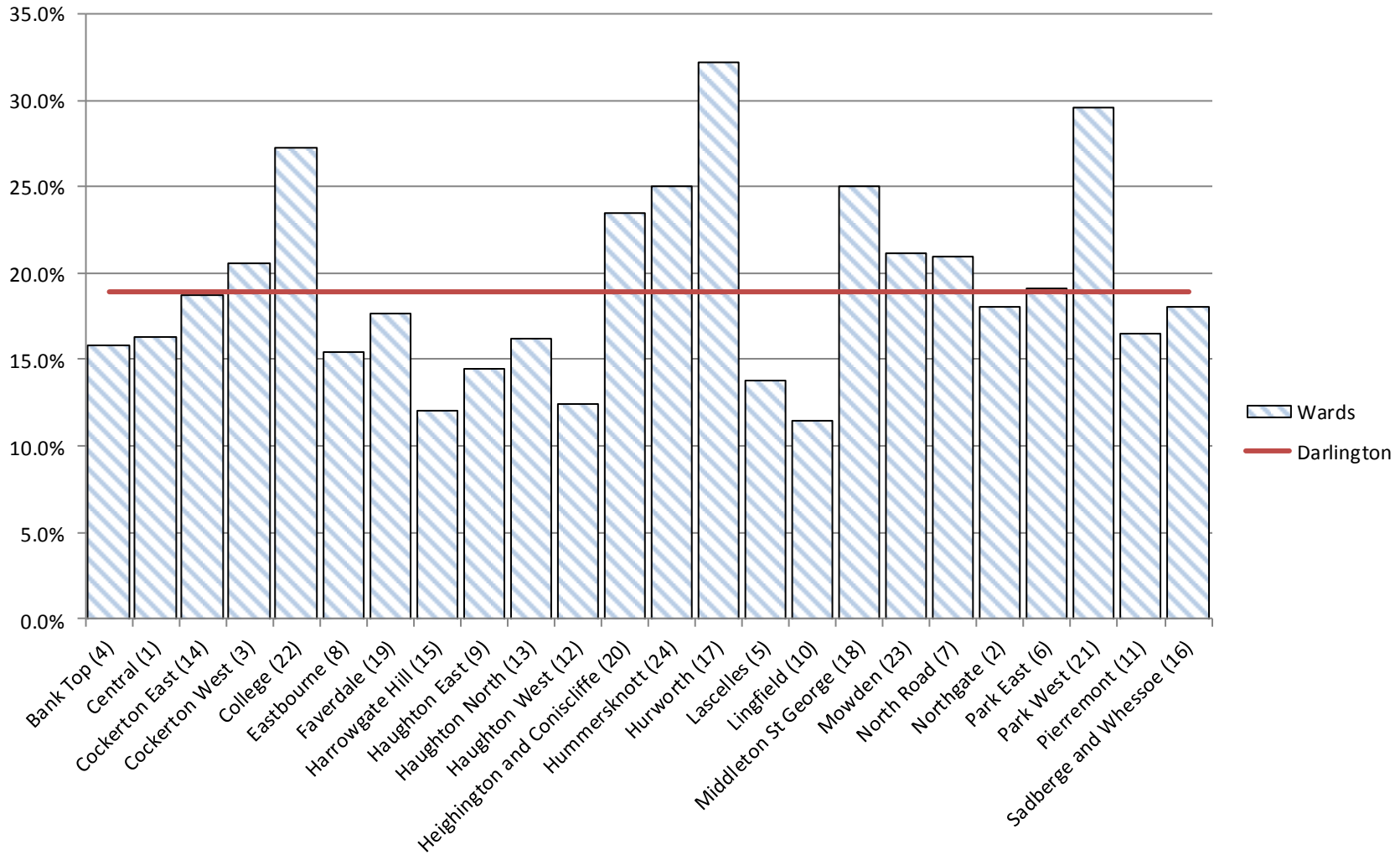

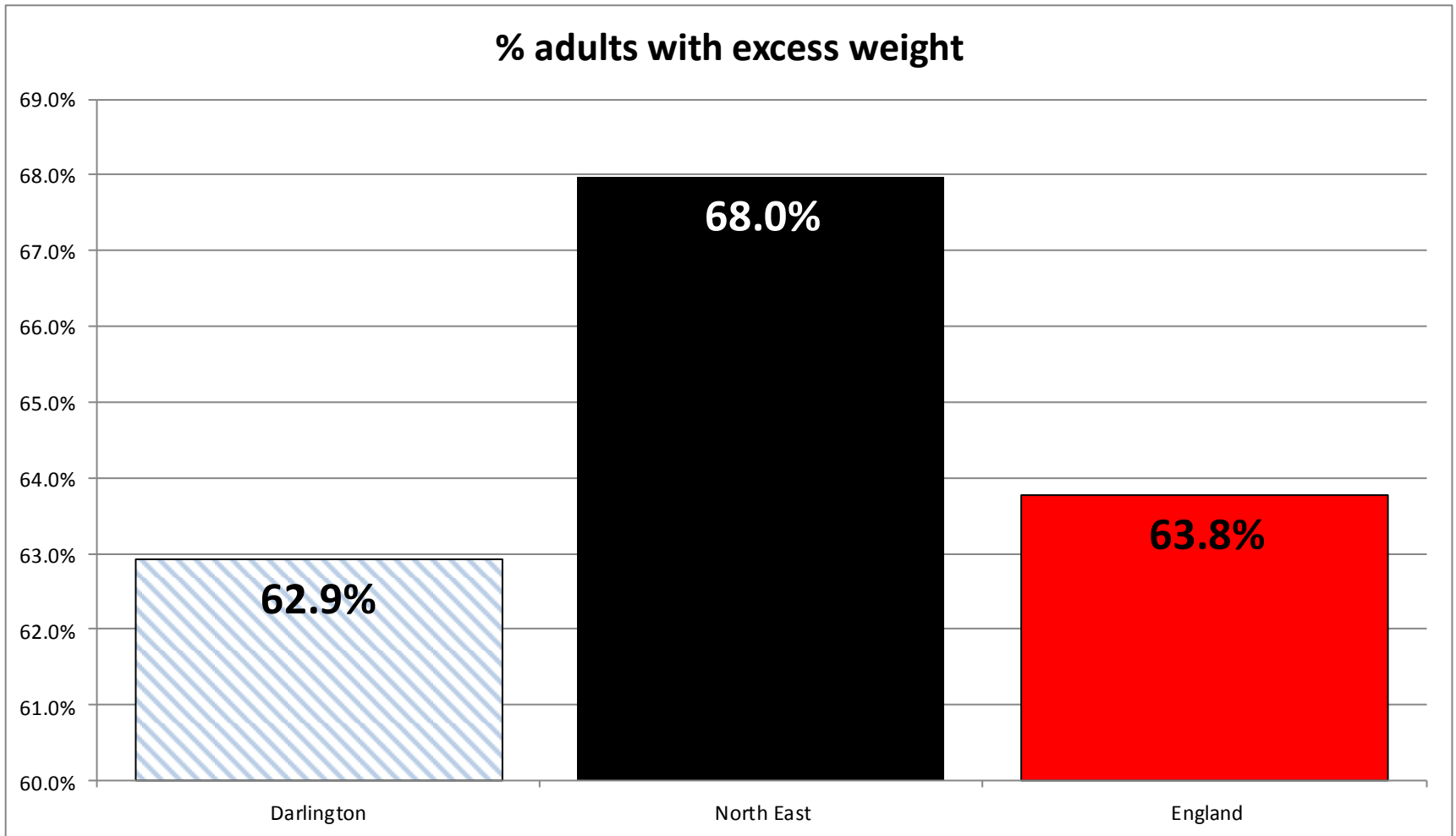

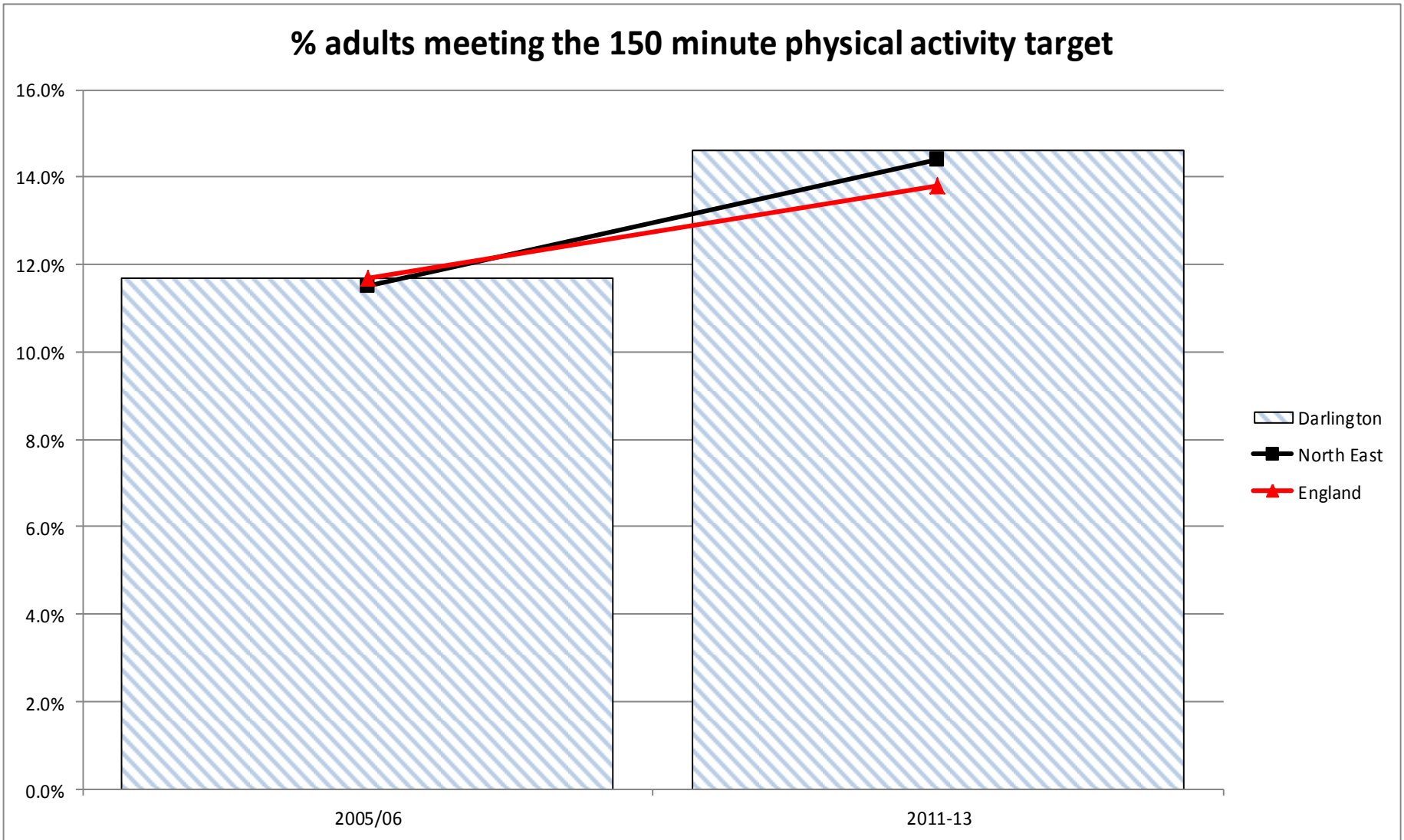

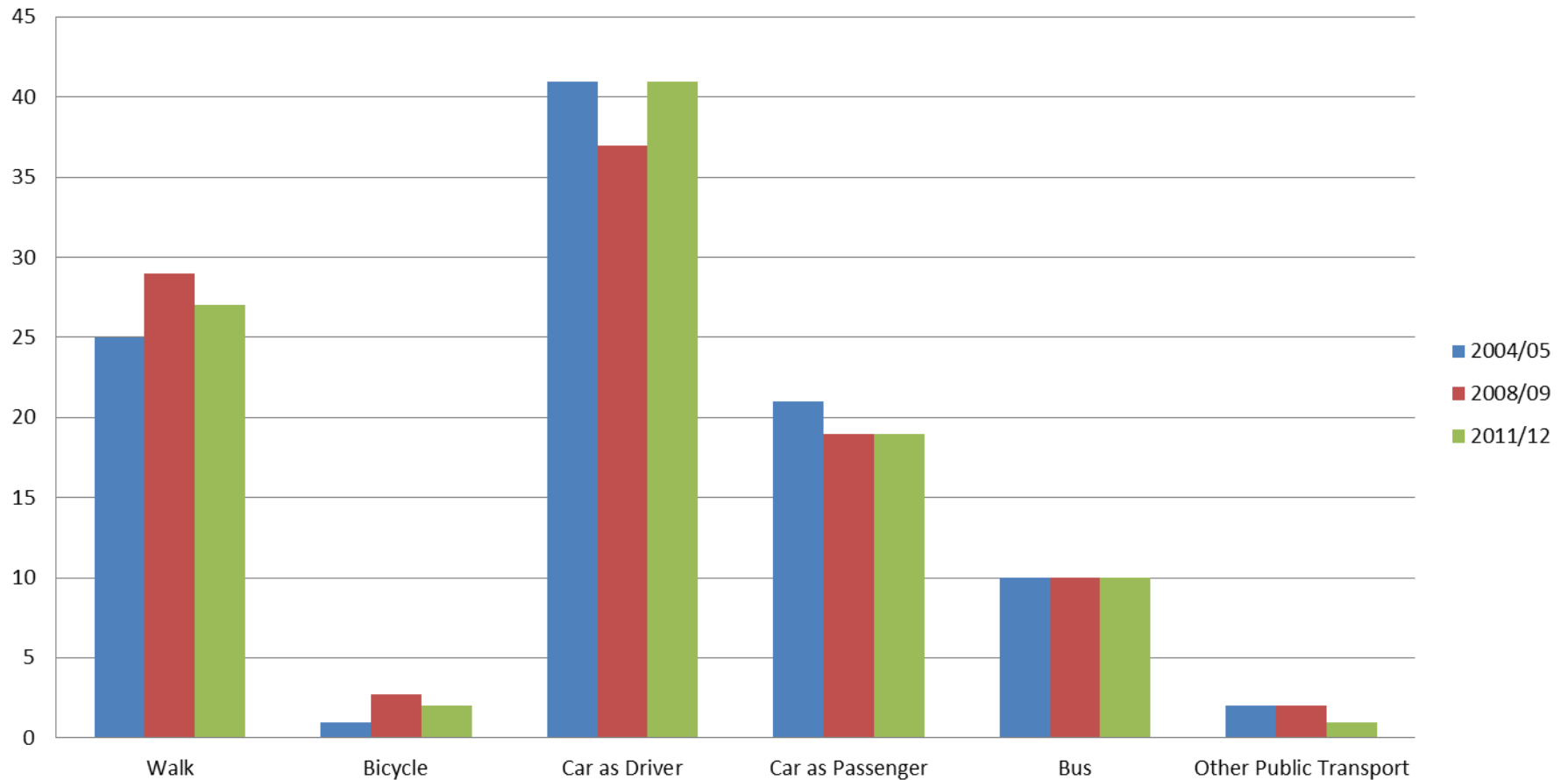

% adults meeting the 150 minute physical activity target



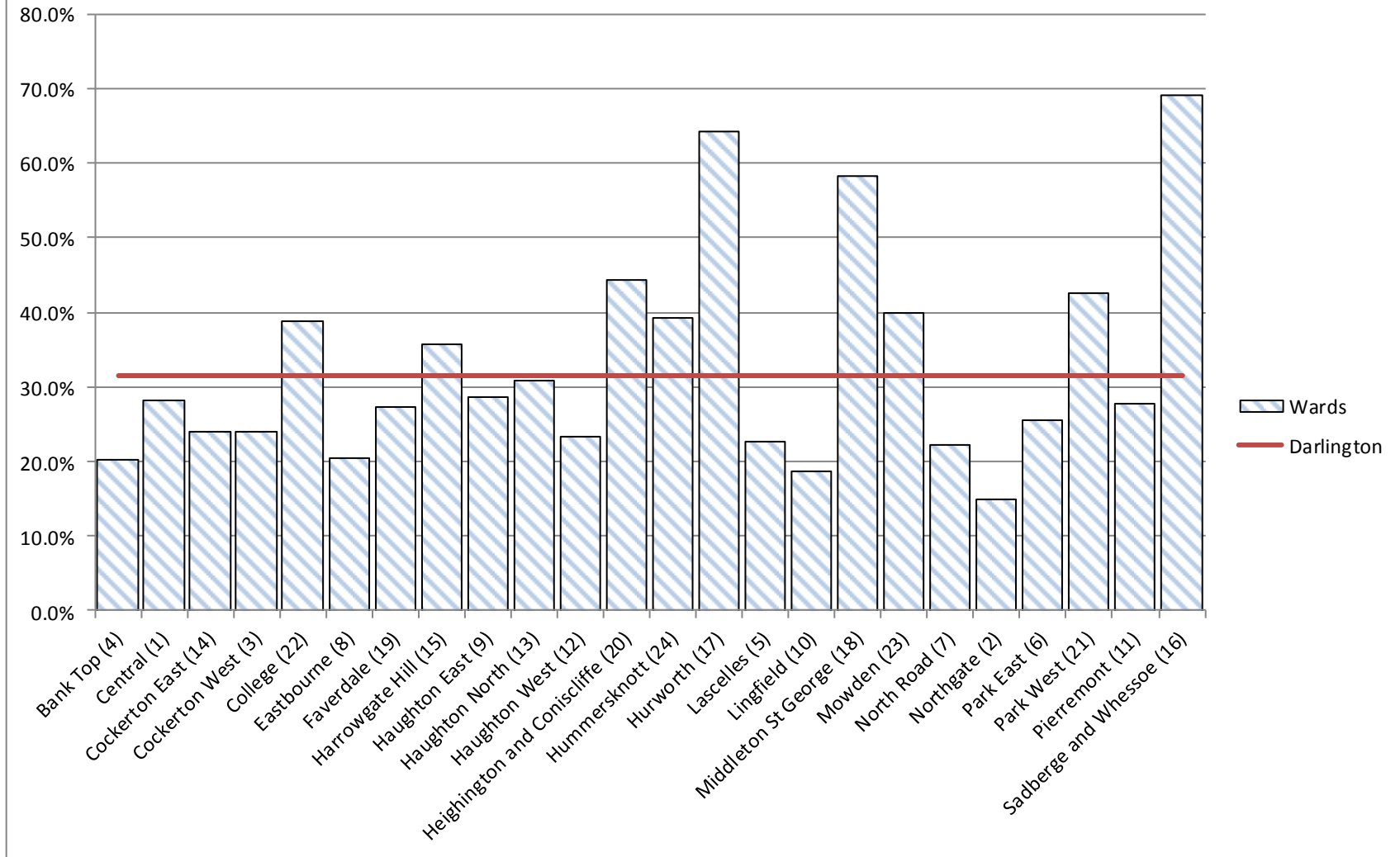

2004-2012



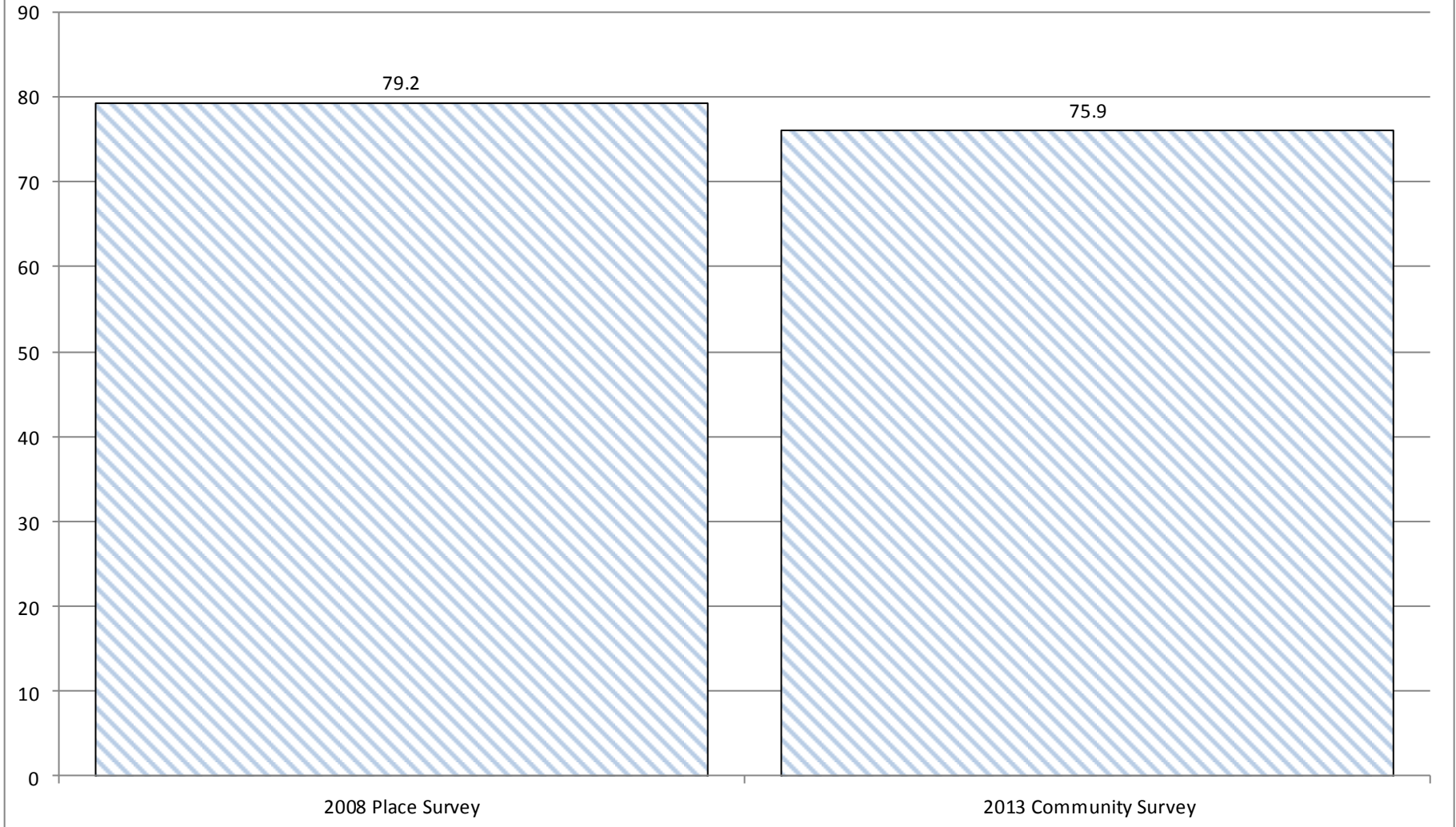

% of residents who strongly or tend to agree that there is a lot of community spirit in their area (2013)



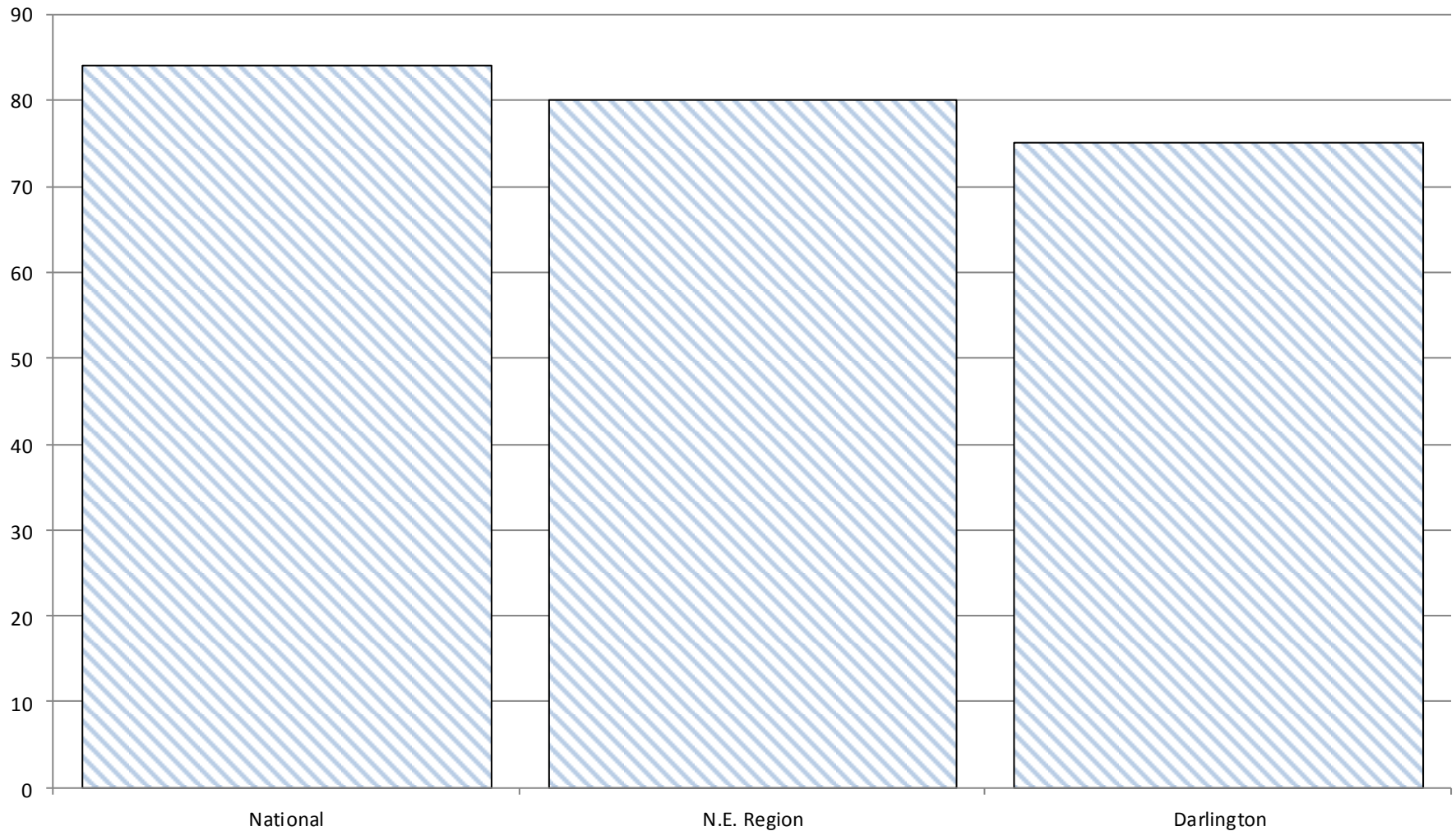

(2008 - 2013)**



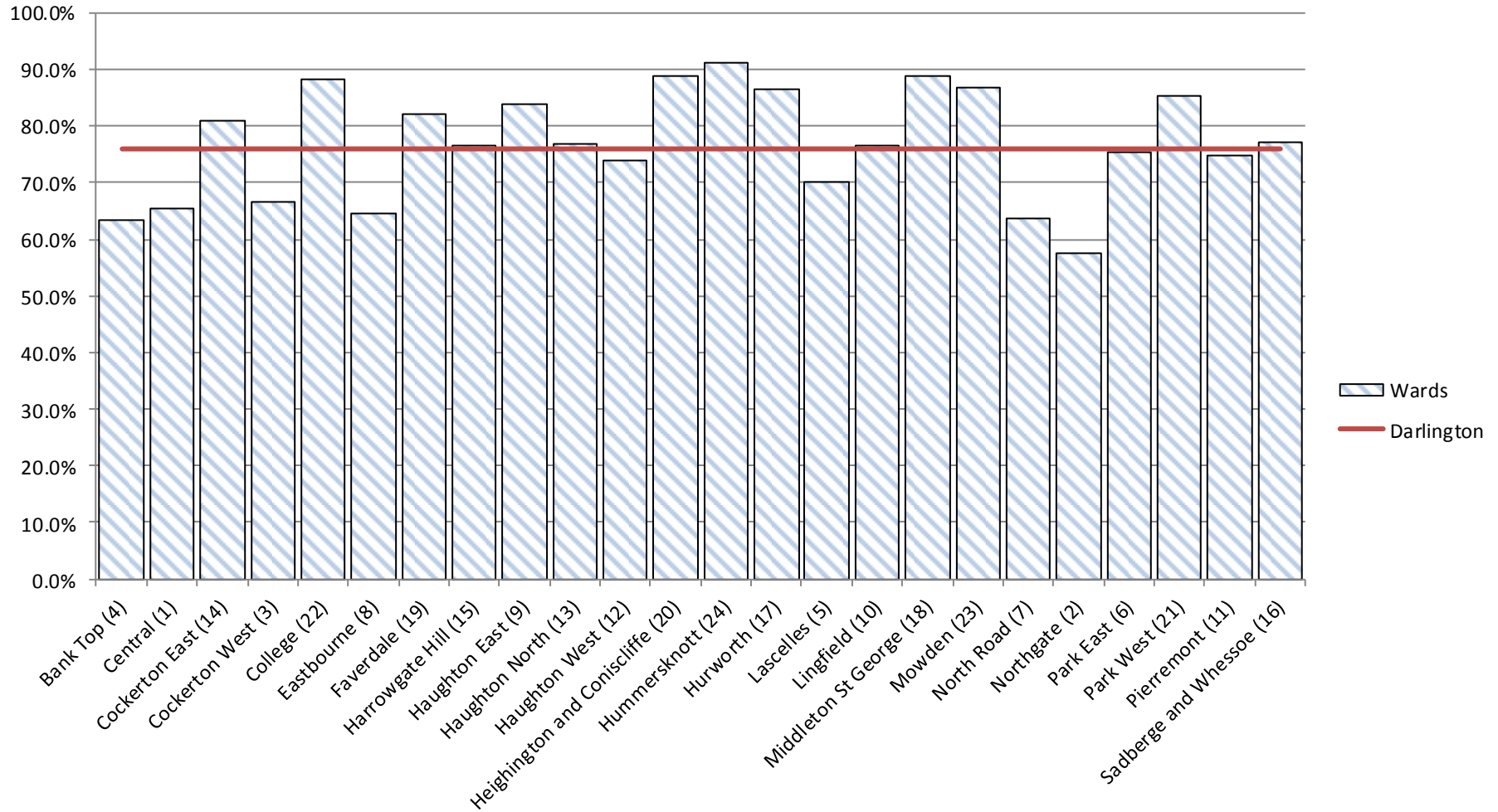

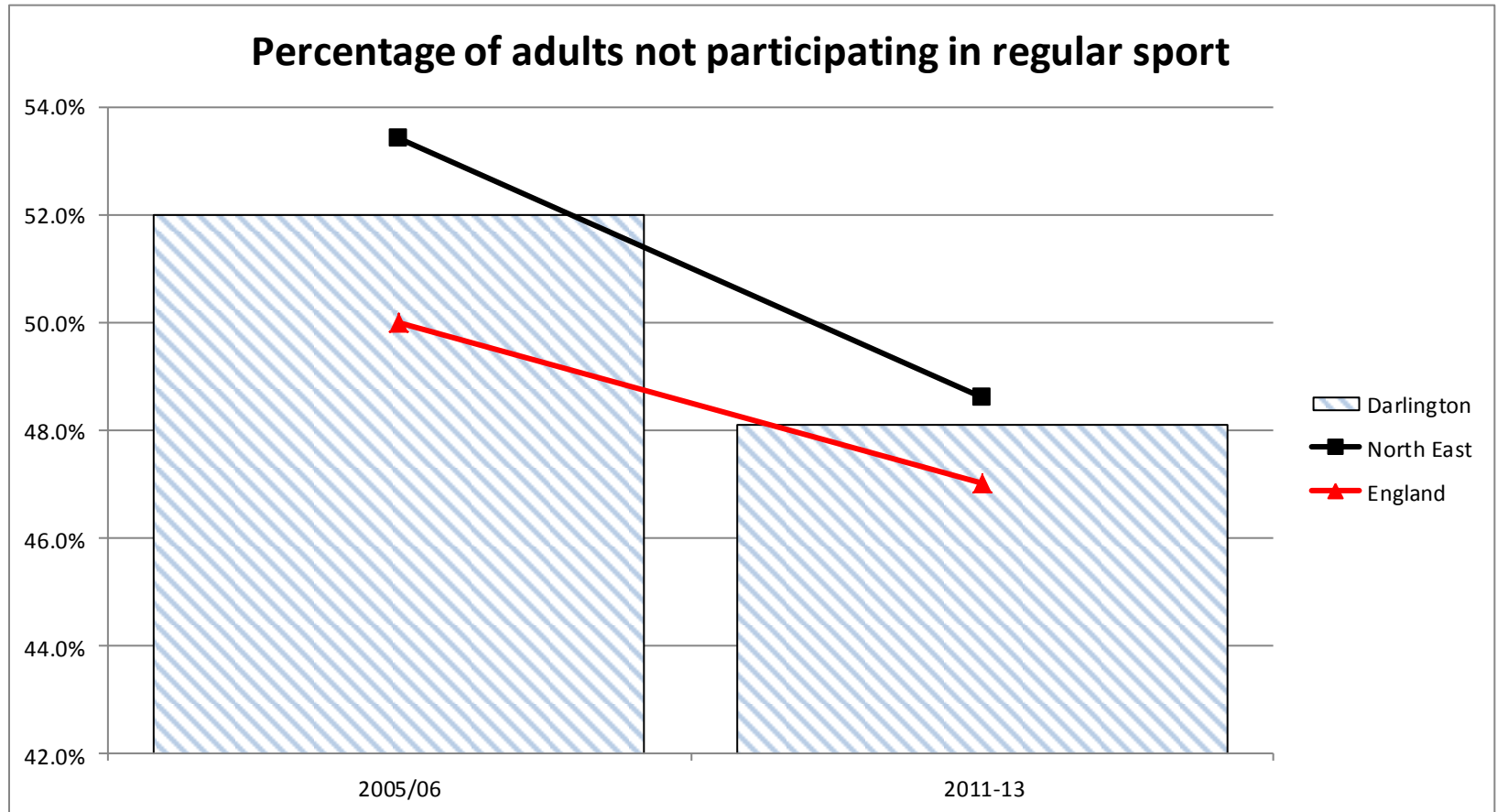

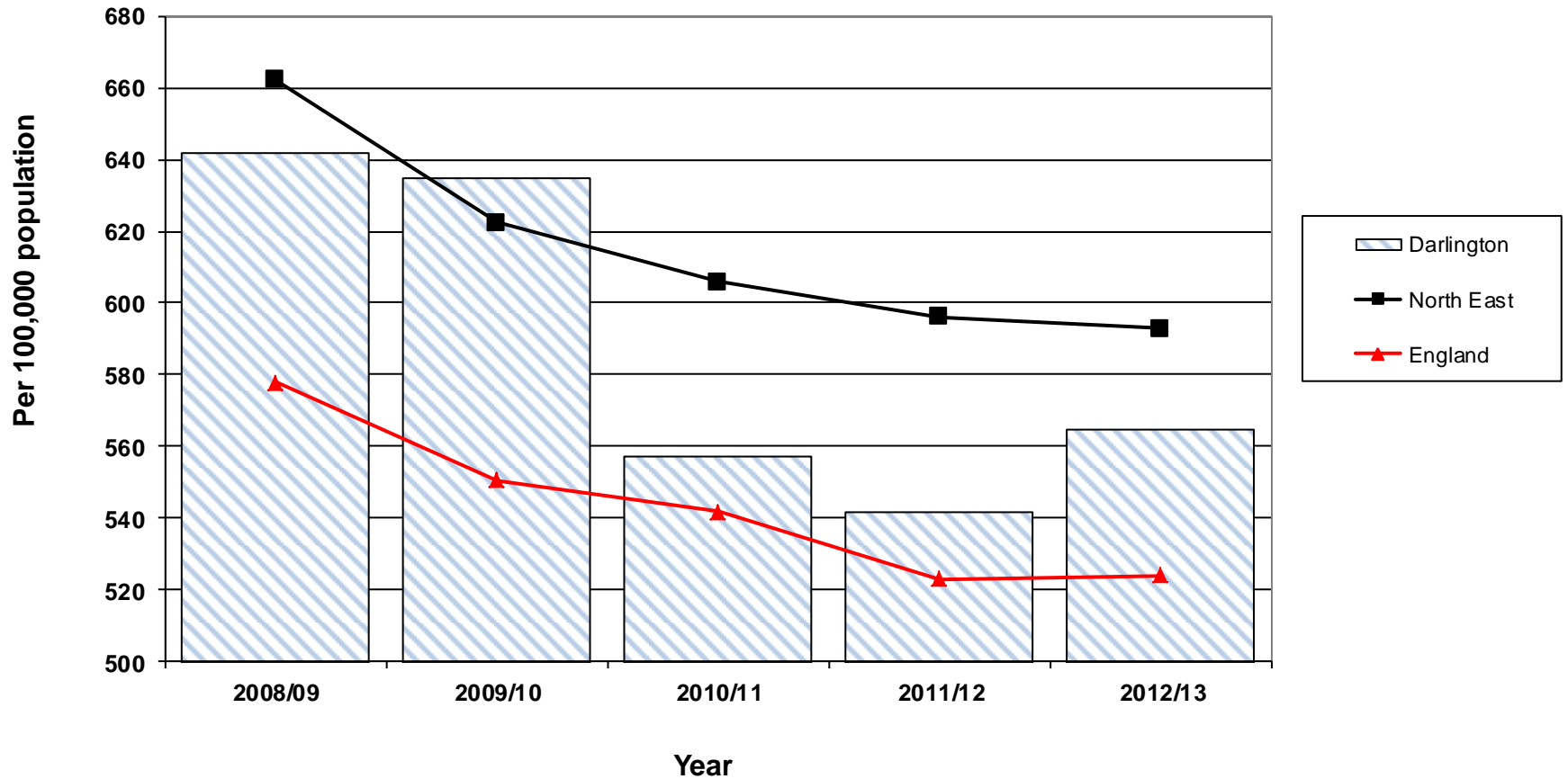

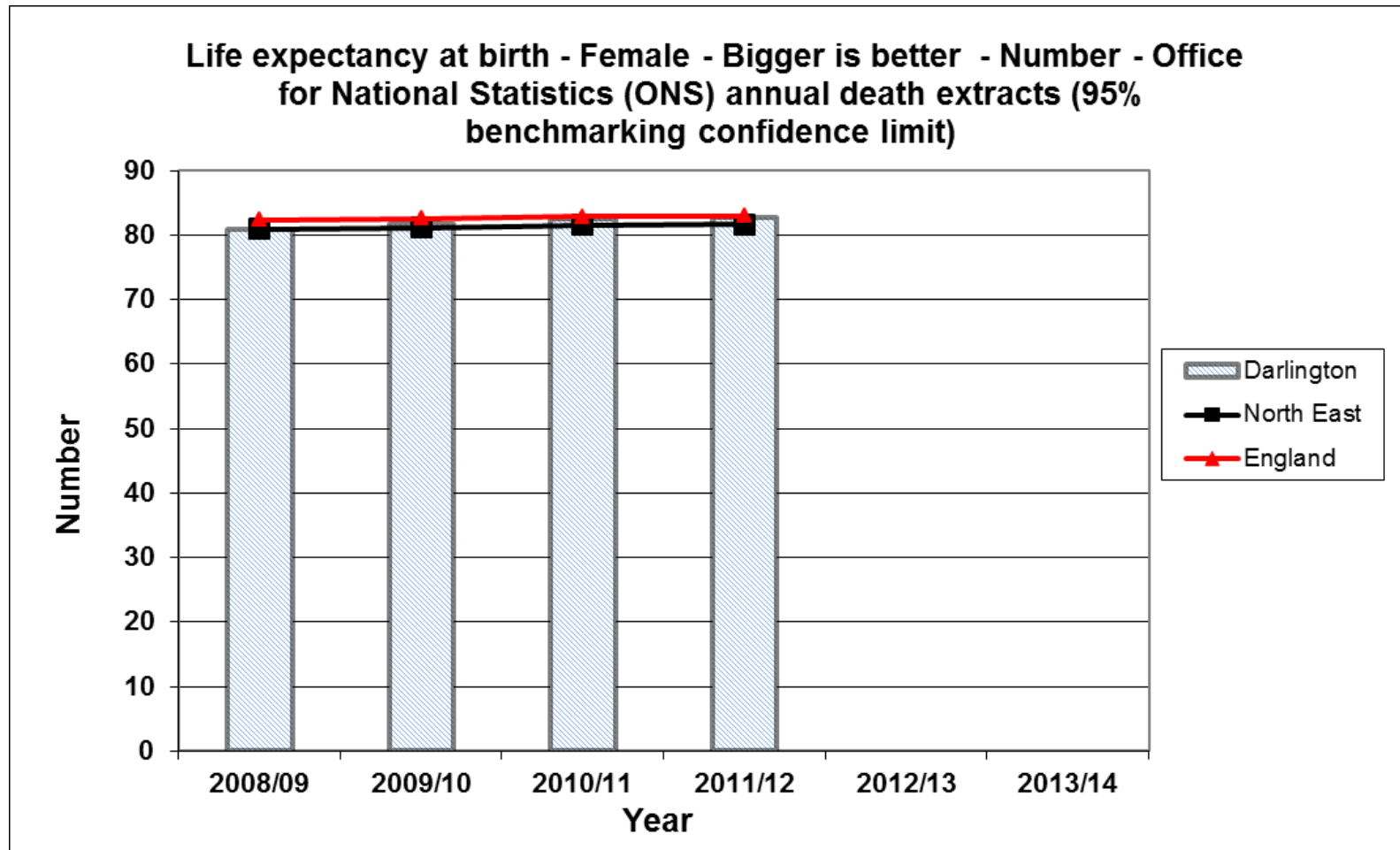

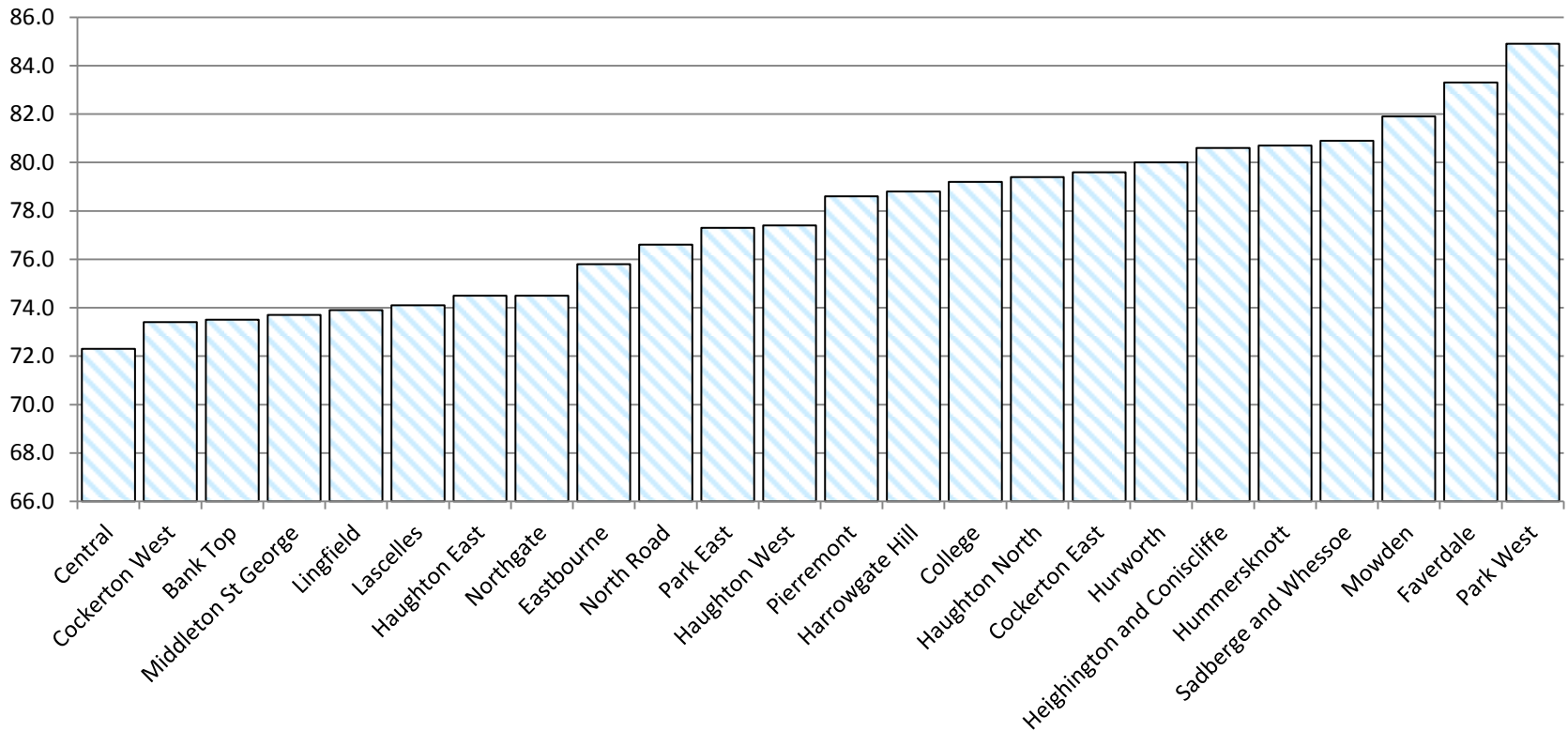

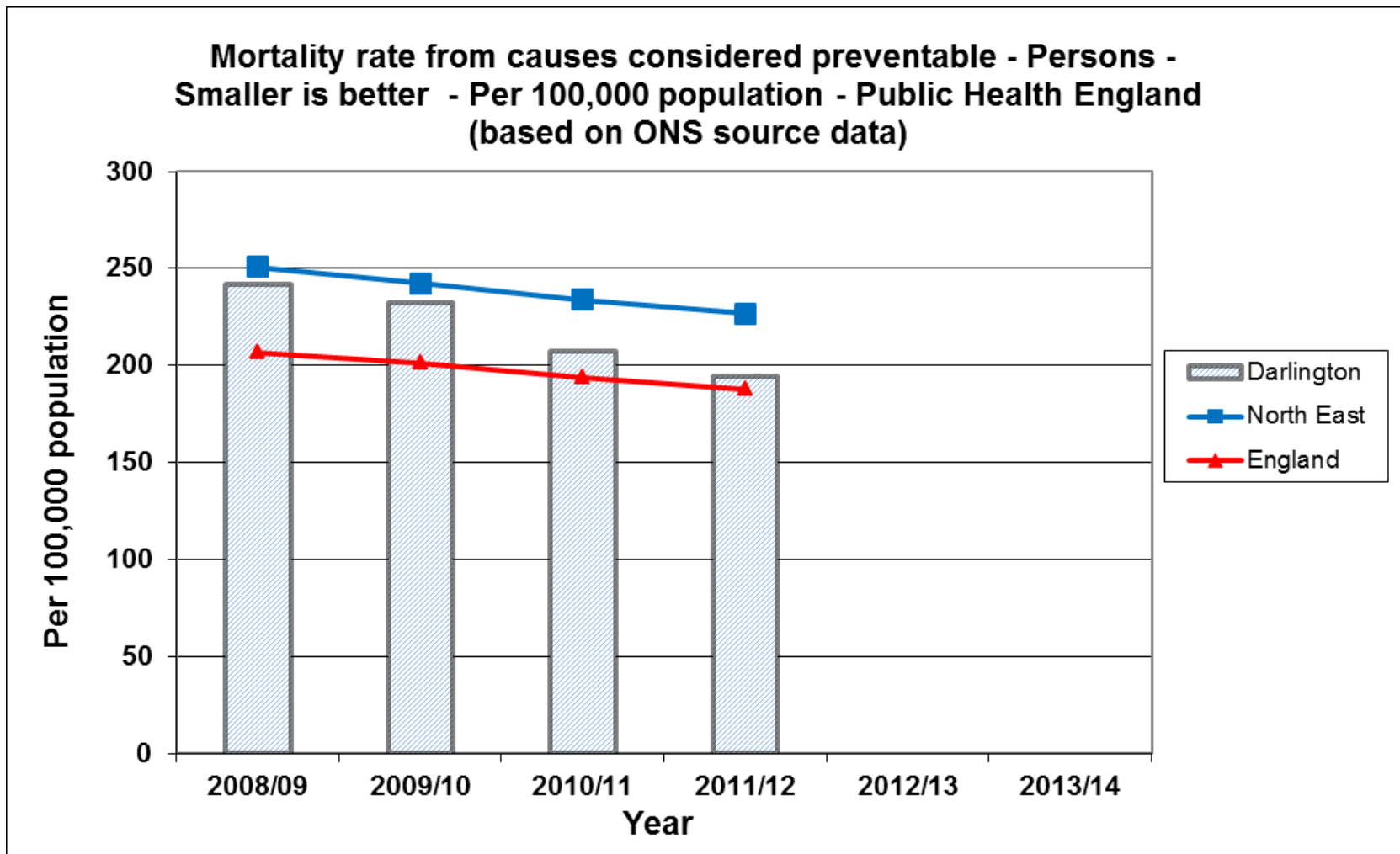

Life Expectancy by Ward (1999-2003)

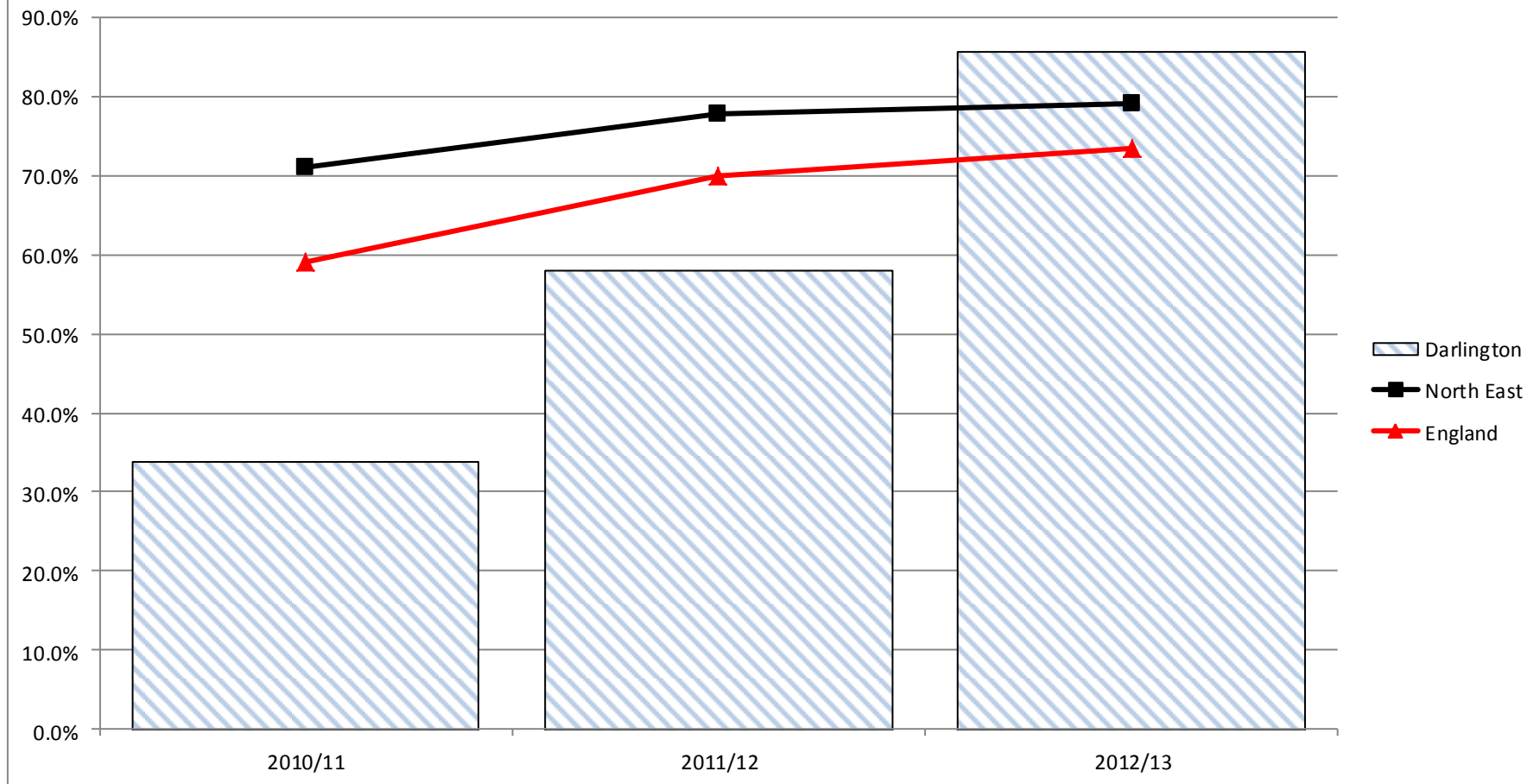

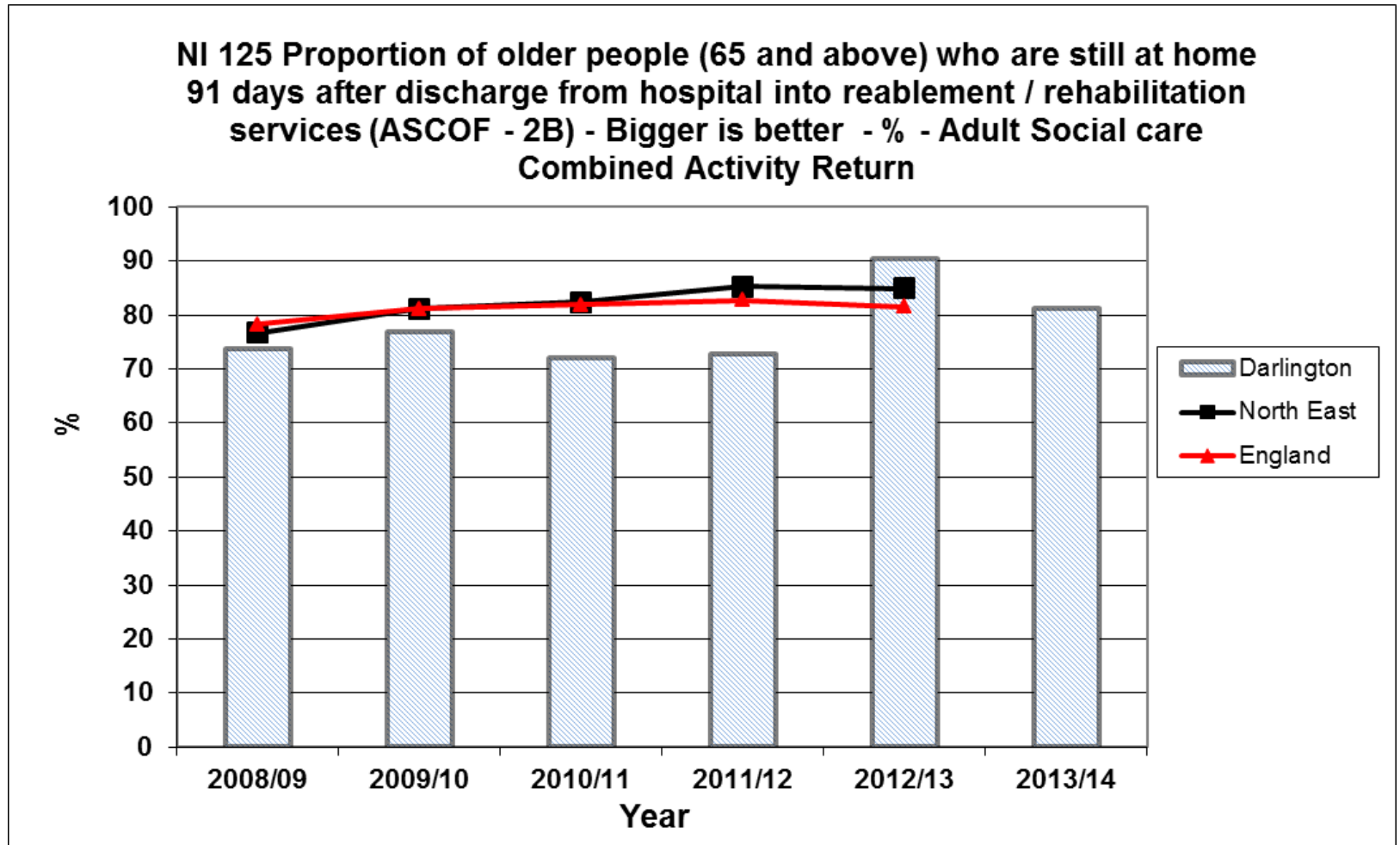

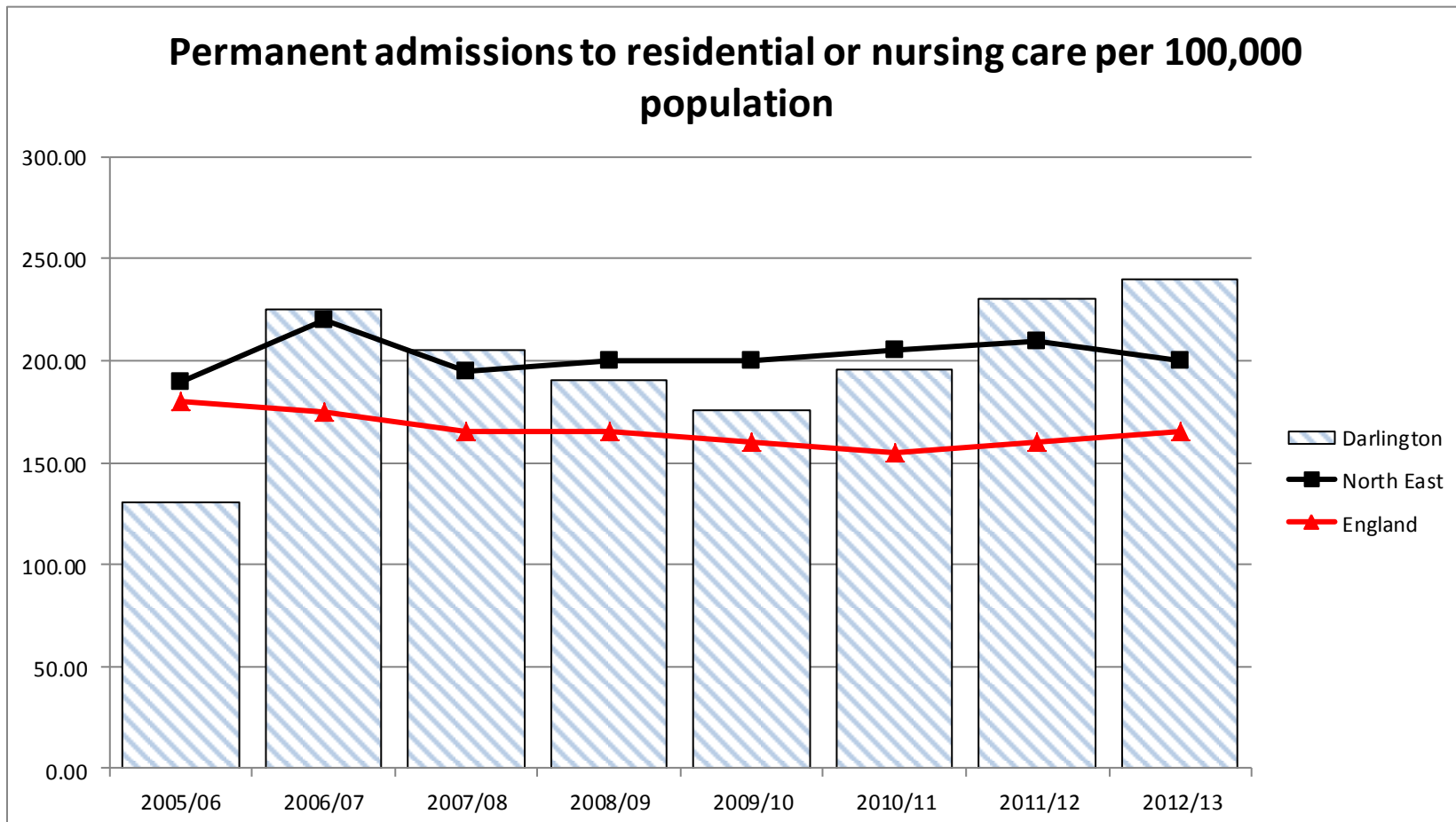
% people with a learning disability who live in their own home or with family



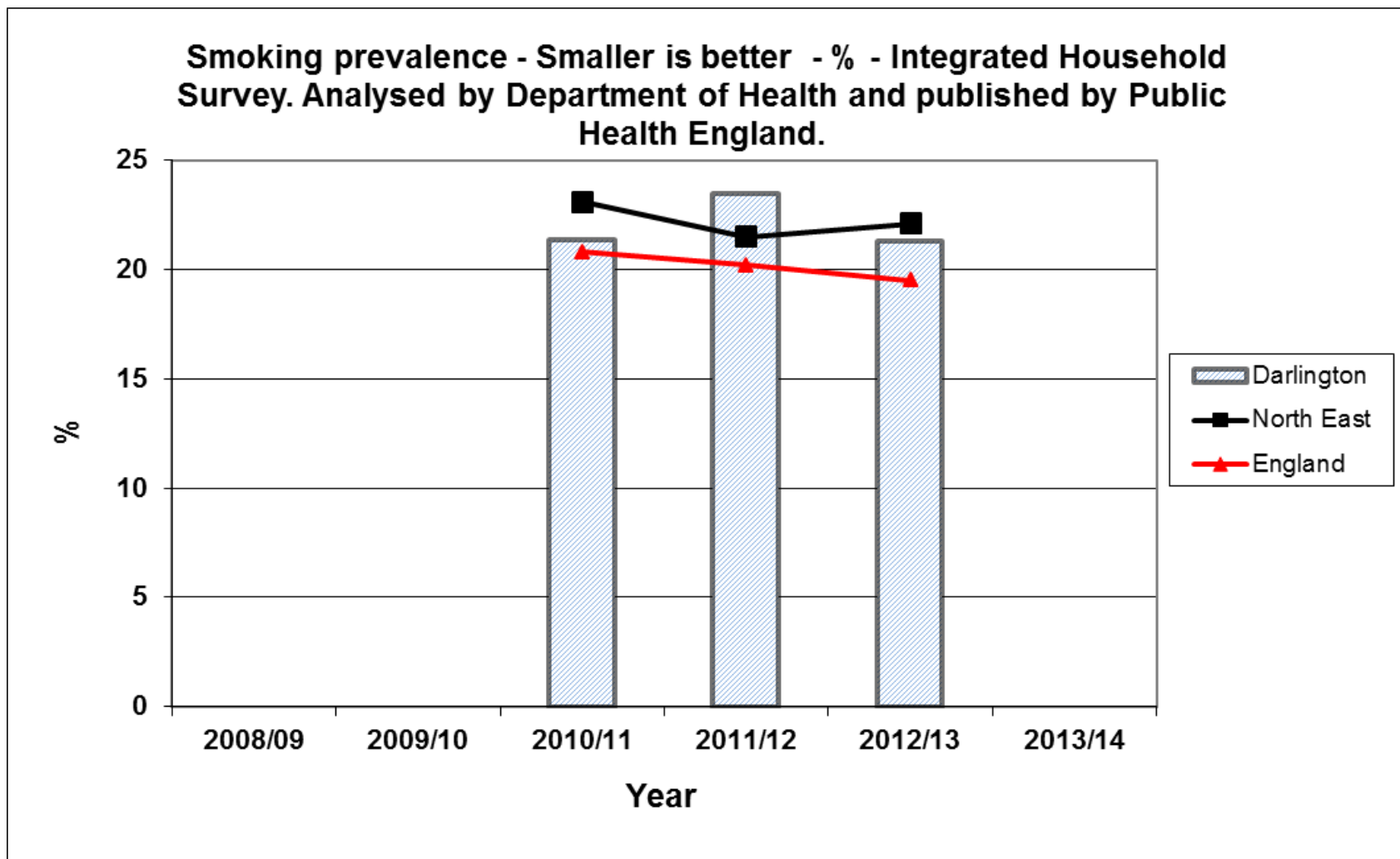

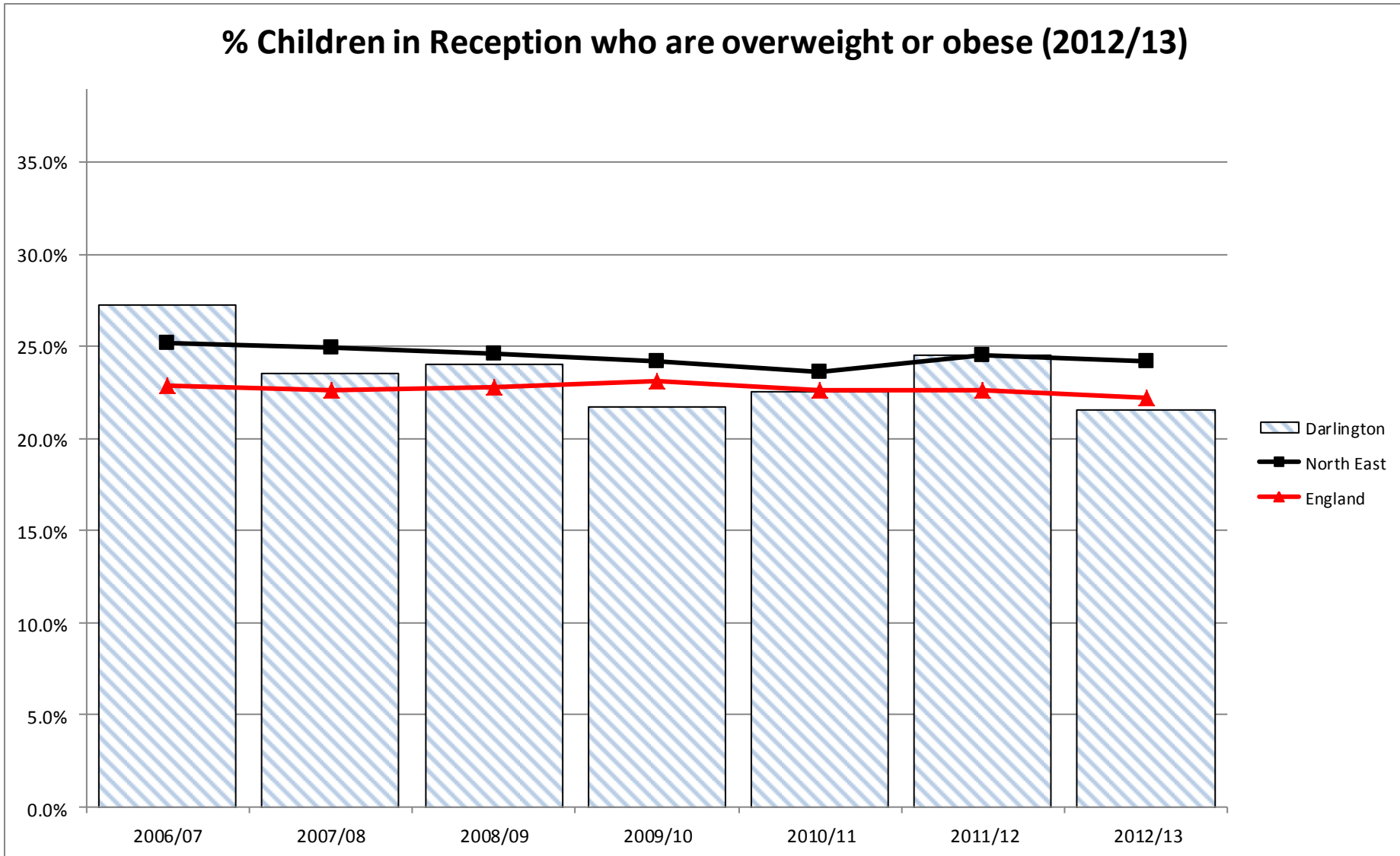

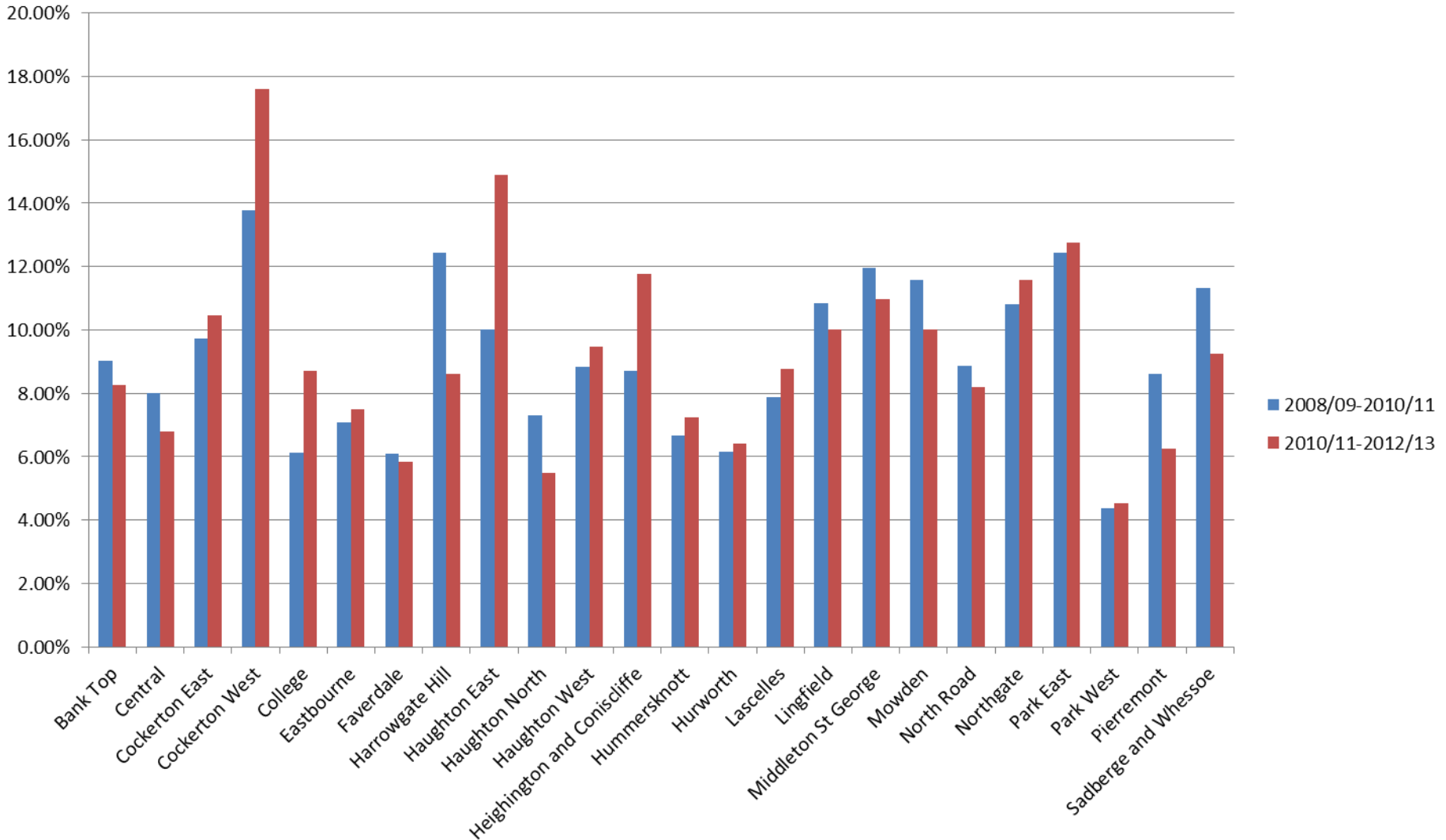

% Children in Reception who are overweight or obese (2012/13)



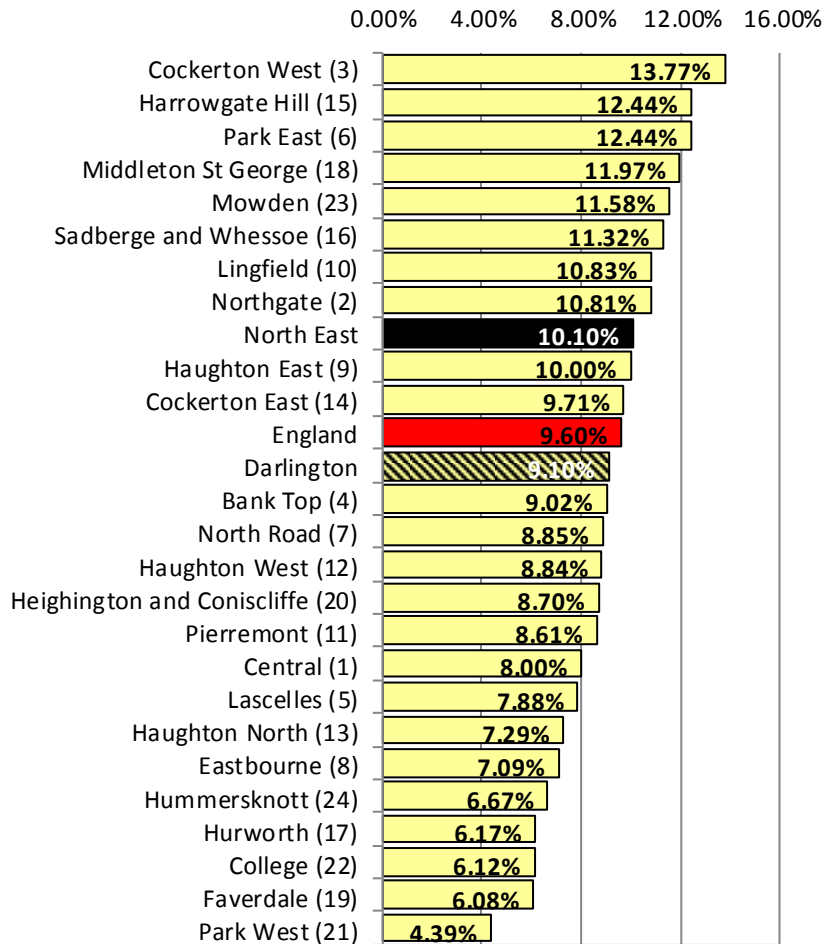

Percentage of Reception age children who are obese (2008/09 - 2012/13)

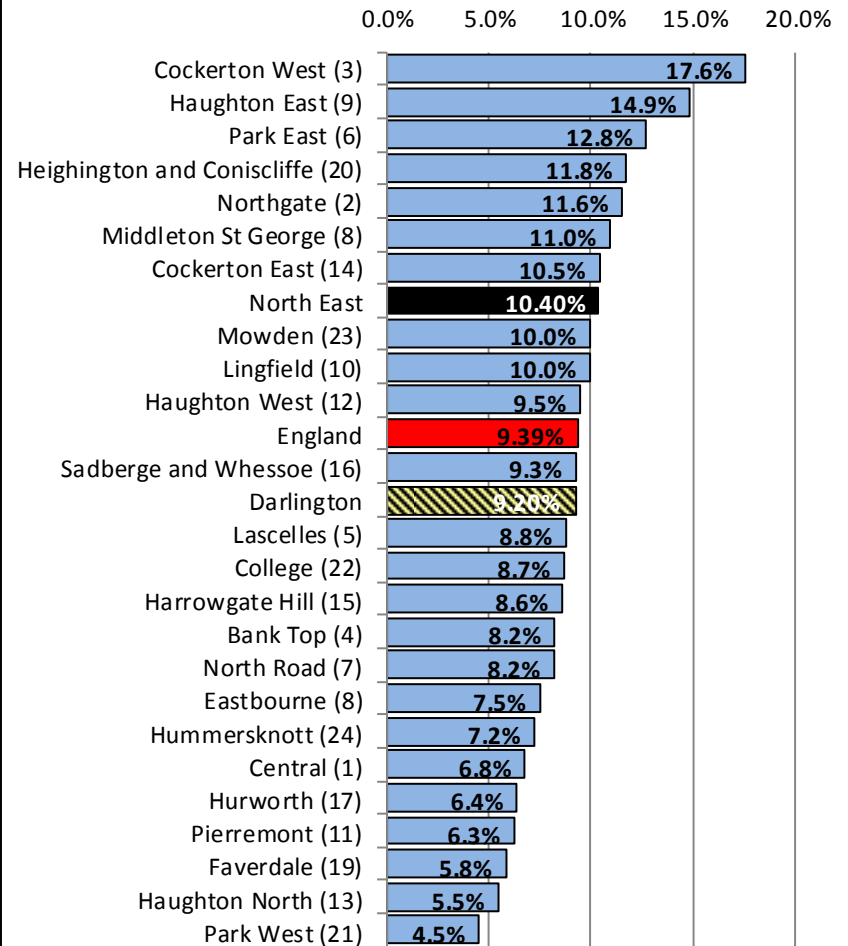

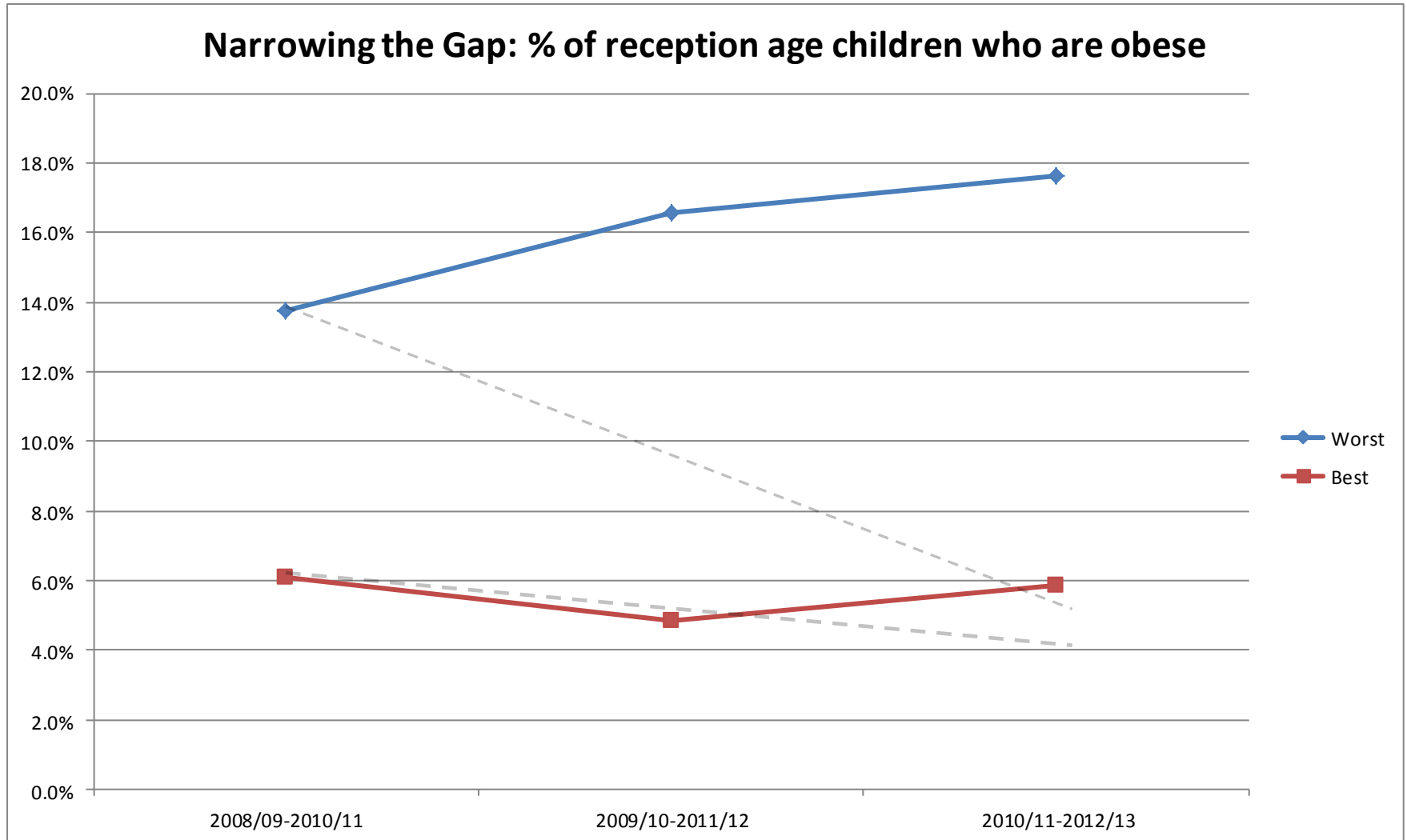
Percentage of Reception age children who were obese (2008/09 - 2010/11)



Percentage of Reception age children who were obese (2010/11 - 2012/13)

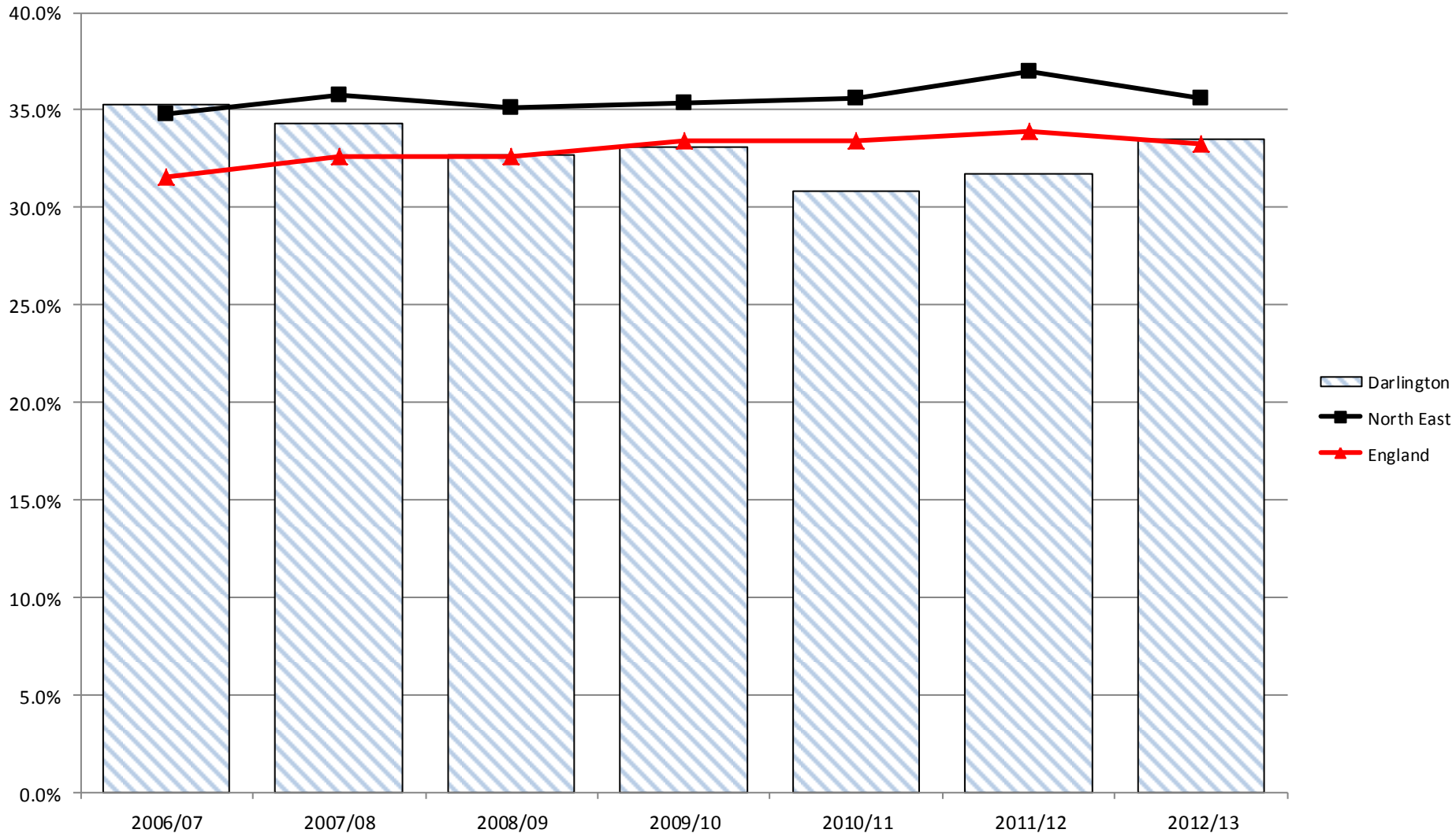

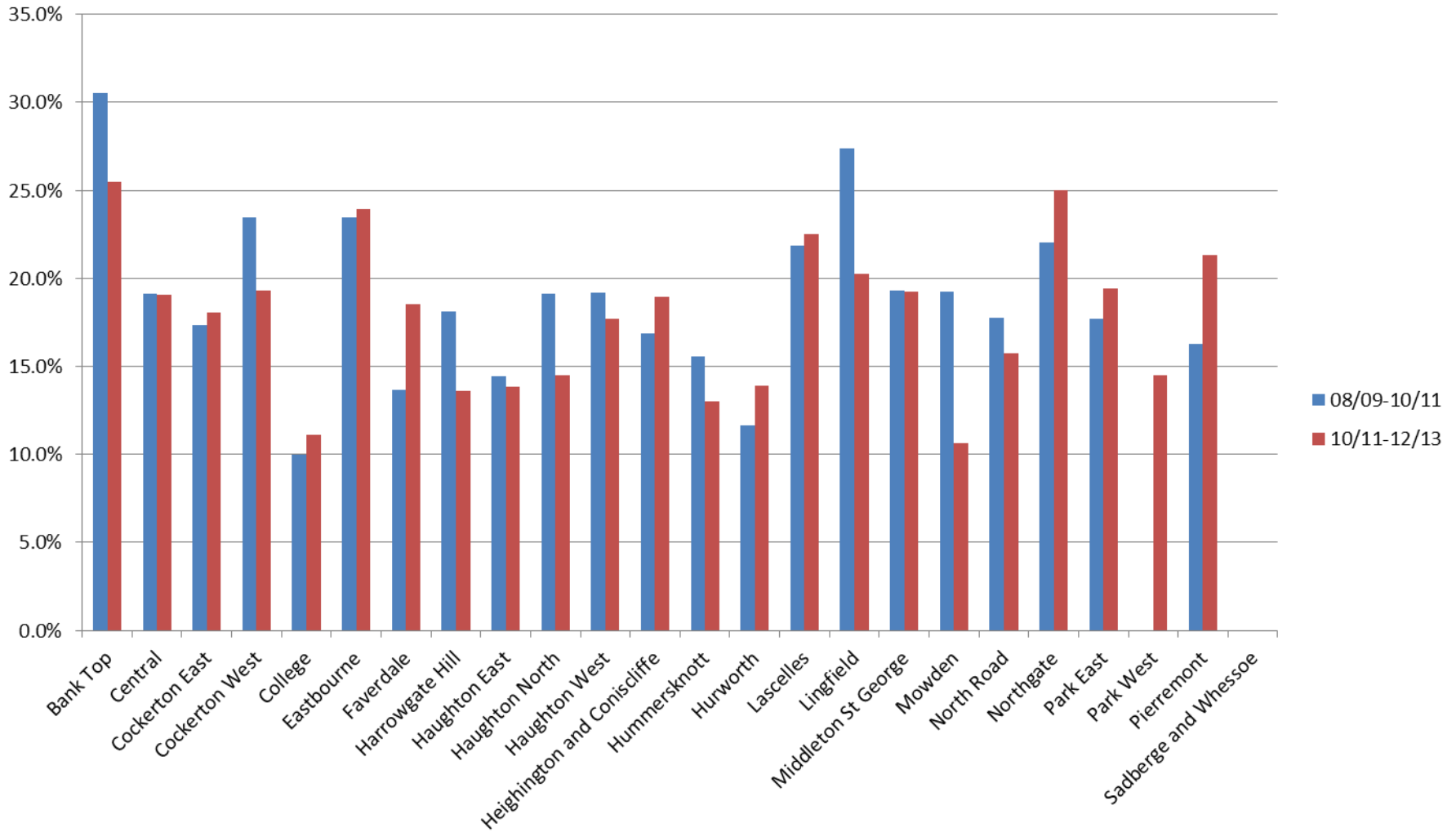

% children overweight or obese in Year 6 (2012/13)



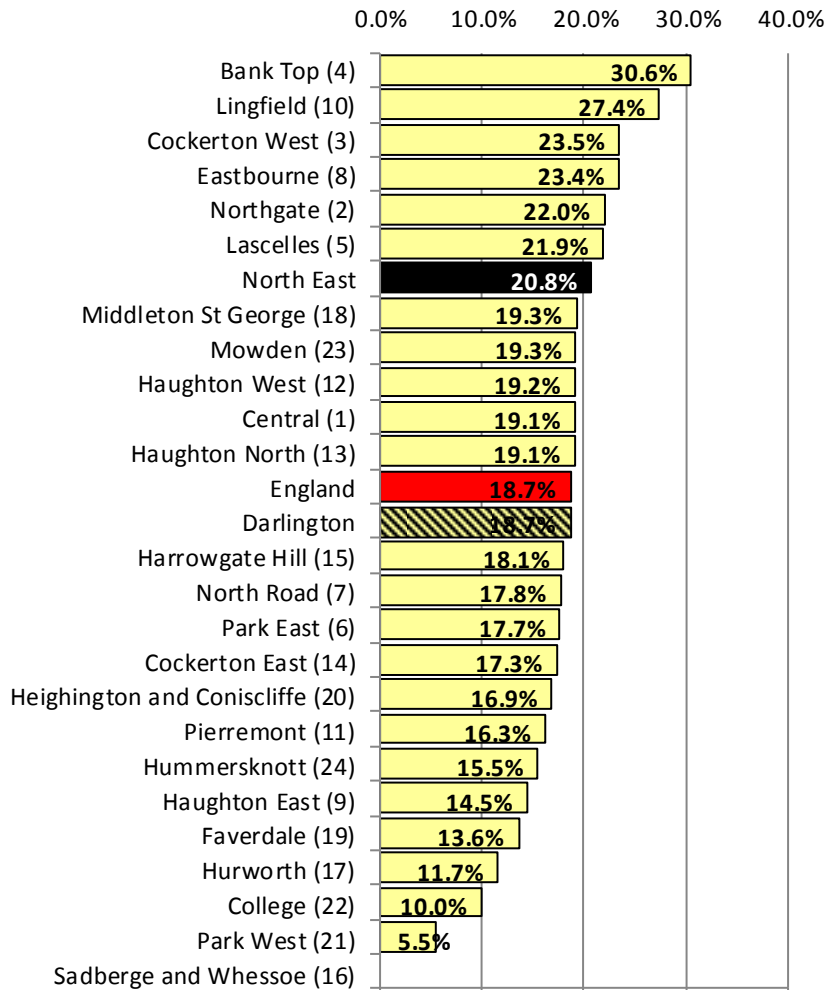

% children in Year 6 who were obese (2008/09 - 2012/13)

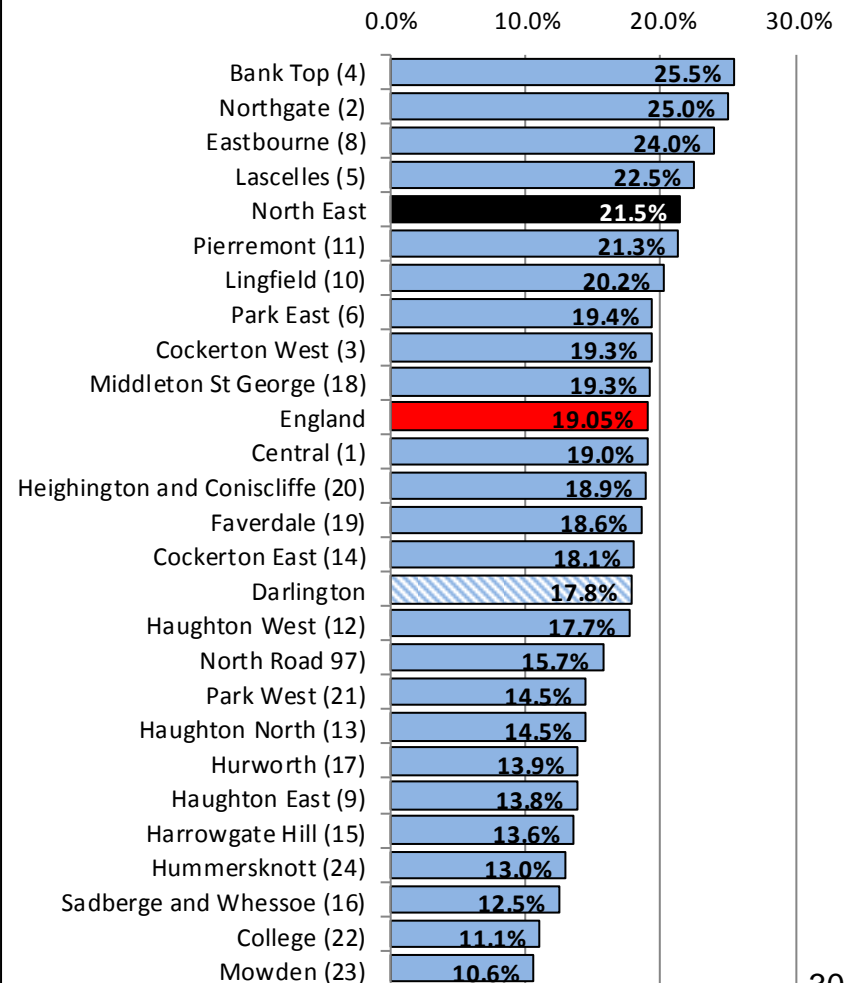
