Devolved Formula Capital	This funding supports 'small-scale' capital projects calculated on formulaic allocations based on the type of school and pupil numbers. It is required to be devolved to schools. Projects undertaken are determined according to locally agreed priorities established in the Asset Management Plan to address both suitability and condition related needs.	£1,448,235
Modernisation	Funding has been allocated for Primary and Secondary Schools. This funding supports larger scale capital works at schools. The funding is allocated on an Authority-by-Authority basis and is based on number and type of schools and total pupil numbers.
