

Summary of Consultation Responses Received

Mowden Junior School

Questioned accept the proposed admission number for the academic year 2009/10.
Their reply was:

The Authority has had discussions with the school regarding increasing its admission number from 60 to 62 and has agreed that it is inline with the school's net capacity.

Dodmire Infant School

Questioned the proposed admission number for the academic year 2009/10, their reply was:

“To accommodate 70 pupils this year we had to have an extra classroom – if we continue to remain at 70 and accept 70 children into a year group we would need extra classrooms. Our capacity to take 70 pupils in each year group was removed when Eastbourne Nursery was brought to Dodmire Infants. A more realistic number would be 60”.

The Authority's response:

The accommodation for the nursery did not impact on the capacity of the infant school, therefore the school continues to have capacity for 70 children in each year group. The Authority is however considering a reduction to 60 as part of the Primary Capital Programme review.
