# **Information and Analysis**

- 3. The Constitution states that decisions taken as a matter of urgency must be reported to the next available meeting of the Council, together with the reasons for urgency and, given below, are details of such decisions taken since the last ordinary meeting of Council held on 26th March 2008.

C192(8)	Housing Investment Programme 2008/09	To ensure that housing capital expenditure for 2008/09 commenced with immediate effect. (Cabinet Urgent Decision).
C192(13)	North East of England Regional Spatial Strategy - Secretary of State's Further Proposed Changes	A decision was required by 2nd April 2008, in order to meet the consultation deadline set by the Secretary of State (Cabinet Urgent Decision).
C204	Land at Whessoe Road, Darlington	To ensure contracts were exchanged before the end of the financial year, as required by British Rail Board (Residuary) Limited. (Cabinet Urgent Decision).
C212	Darlington Housing Strategy 2008/11	To ensure that the Housing Business Plan was delivered and community housing needs met, the Strategy was required to be implemented at the beginning of the financial year or as soon as possible thereafter.  (Cabinet Urgent Decision).
C219	Supported Bus Service Contract	In order to ensure contacts be awarded within required timescales, to allow the service to be implemented with effect from 20 <sup>th</sup> July 2008. (Cabinet Urgent Decision).
