- 5. In addition, I, as Chair, have raised a question about the Council's position in relation to Premier Waste Management and have been re-assured by the response received from Officers and I am in the process of obtaining information about funding which was allocated to enable training to be undertaken for care homes to meet the Gold Standard Framework which I will report back to Scrutiny if necessary.
