CPA USE OF RESOURCES - ASSESSMENT RESULTS 2007

Purpose of Report

1. To present the external audit report on the CPA Use of Resources assessment for 2007.

Information and Analysis

- 2. Attached is a copy of the report produced by PriceWaterhouseCoopers (PwC) following the 2007 Use of Resources assessment. The assessment was completed in accordance with the methodology and guidance issued by the Audit Commission.
- 3. Representatives from PwC will attend the meeting to present the report.
- 4. The outcome from the assessment is positive. Overall the Council scored a level 3 i.e. performing well consistently above minimum requirements. This overall score is the same as that received in 2006, however, year on year the bar continues to be raised in terms of scoring requirements.
- 5. Nevertheless progress has been made both at theme level and within themes and no scores have reduced. The score for the Value for Money theme has increased from 3 to 4 i.e. performing strongly well above minimum requirements and the theme elements for 'the council manages performance against budgets' and 'the council manages its significant business risks' within the Financial Management and Internal Control themes have increased from 2 to 3 and 3 to 4 respectively.

Legal Implications

6. This report has been considered by the Borough Solicitor for legal implications in accordance with the Council's approved procedures. There are no issues which the Borough Solicitor considers need to be brought to the specific attention of Members, other than those highlighted in the report.
