

Radios, CD Players and the Like

A No radios, CD players and the like will be permitted on to or used on the site and the Contractor shall notify his workforce, Subcontractors and the like accordingly.

Pollution

B The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to prevent pollution arising from the execution of the works. His specific attention is drawn to the fact that on no account will he be allowed to burn demolition or any other rubbish on site and all such rubbish must be removed from site.

Statute

C The Contractor shall allow for compliance with all obligations imposed by statute and not referred to elsewhere in this document.

Maintain Public and Private Roads and Adjacent Areas

The Contractor will be responsible for the protection of all roads, kerbs, tarmac, paved or grassed areas adjacent to the works, all site boundaries and also trees and hedging on or adjacent to the site, any damage occasioned to these during the progress of the works must be made good at his own expense.

The Maintenance of Existing Live Drainage, Water and Other Mains or Power Services on the Site

E It is essential that extreme care should be used in any excavations undertaken in this contract with regard to underground services and in particular any which serve the adjoining premises.

F Notwithstanding the absence from the drawings of any other gas, electric, water and telephone services, sewers, etc. the Contractor shall ascertain for himself the position of all and any services by liaising with the relevant authorities before commencement of excavations.

G No mechanical excavation or stakes will be permitted within 3 metres of the approximate position of a vulnerable service until the exact position of the service has been discovered by trial holes. After its position has been ascertained, excavations within one metre of the service must be performed by hand under the supervision of the appropriate public utility representative. Stakes will not be permitted within this distance. The rates for excavation, etc. are to include for complying with this Clause.

H The Contractor shall be solely responsible for the location of and temporary protection of supports thereto of all services and the Project Manager shall issue instructions with regard to any permanent protection or division which may be required.
