### SUMMARY REPORT

#### Purpose of the Report

 To discuss the service and governance implications for Darlington of the draft Sustainability and Transformation Plan 2016-21 for Darlington, Durham Dales, Easington and Sedgefield, Hambleton, Richmondshire and Whitby, Hartlepool and Stockton-on-Tees and South Tees. #### Summary

- 2. The attached draft Sustainability and Transformation Plan (Appendix 1) describes the local 'footprint' response to the challenges identified in the NHS England Five Year Forward View 2014.
- 3. The plan describes our ambition for the future and focuses on four areas of improvement including Preventing ill health and increasing self-care; Health and care communities and neighbourhoods; Quality of care in our hospitals; and the Use of technology in health care.
- 4. Whilst the plan encourages an approach to improvement across a large geography where services span a broader population base, it is also consistent with and supports the local engagement and development work currently taking place as part of the Darlington Vision and Blueprint.
