### **SUMMARY REPORT**

## **Purpose of the Report**

 To present the outcome and findings of the Review Group established by the Adults and Housing Scrutiny Committee to look at the dementia pathway and the support and advice services available in Darlington and to consider a specific recommendation within the remit of this Scrutiny Committee.

#### **Summary**

- At a meeting of the Adults and Housing Scrutiny Committee held in November 2015, it was agreed to establish a Dementia Review Group to look at the dementia pathway and the support and advice services available in Darlington.
