APPLICATION TO TRANSFER AND VARY THE DESIGNATED PREMISES SUPERVISOR IN RESPECT OF A PREMISES LICENCE – VICTORIA MINI MARKET, 99 VICTORIA ROAD - The Director of Economic Growth submitted a report (previously circulated) to consider an application to transfer the Premises Licence and vary the Designated Premises Supervisor in respect of Victoria Mini Market, 99 Victoria Road, Darlington in light of representations from a Responsible Authority, namely Durham Constabulary in respect of the prevention of crime and disorder, being the only statutory consultee for both parts of this application.
