#### APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE

### **Purpose of Report**

1. To invite Members to consider an application for a premises licence in the light of representations from a Responsible Authority namely Trading Standards on the grounds of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder. In addition to consider the relevance of a representation from "Other Persons" namely anonymous residents. Members should note that this application was due to be considered on 27 March 2014 but was deferred as Members required the Applicant to attend the hearing.
