WHY DOES THE COUNCIL HAVE TO PROVIDE THIS SERVICE AND WHAT DOES IT NEED TO COVER?

The Council operates a number of services that trade with other public sector bodies and other areas of the Council, including works on capital projects. These traded services include:-

General highway maintenance services which include fixing roads, pavements, signs and street lighting.

Delivery of large projects which can include new schools, school extensions, housing projects, road improvements, bridge projects, car parks and refurbishment projects that are either funded by the Council or by money from other sources.

Building Services provide a building and maintenance service primarily to in-house services such as Council Housing, Schools and Corporate buildings and structures.

The provision of the School Meals service to junior schools across the borough and the provision of catering services within sheltered housing accommodation.

The provision of Building Cleaning services to over 40 schools and Council offices as well as over 75 housing locations.

They deliver surplus income over expenditure which is available to fund other services.

They supply services to other statutory services such as Schools, Housing Revenue Account and Highways Maintenance.
