### SUMMARY REPORT

### **Purpose of the Report**

1. To consider an application on behalf of Councillor Stenson for an extension to the six-month period of his non-attendance at meetings due to ill health.

### Summary

- 2. Section 85 of the Local Government Act 1972 states that if a Member of a Local Authority fails throughout a period of six consecutive months, from the date of his/her last attendance, to attend any meeting of the authority, he/she shall, unless the failure was due to some reason approved by the authority before the expiry of that period, cease to be a Member of the Authority.
- 3. Councillor Stenson has not attended any Council or Committee meetings since 29 September 2016 and consequently under the above provisions he will cease to be a Member of the Council on 28 March 2017 unless the Council approves the reason for the failure to attend before that date.

## MAIN REPORT

### Information and Analysis

- 6. Section 85 of the Local Government Act 1972 states that if a Member of a Local Authority fails throughout a period of six consecutive months, from the date of his/her last attendance, to attend any meeting of the authority, he/she shall, unless the failure was due to some reason approved by the authority before the expiry of that period, cease to be a Member of the Authority.
- 7. Councillor Stenson has not attended any Council or Committee meetings since 29 September 2016 due to ill health, consequently under the above provisions he will cease to be a Member of the Council on 28th March, 2017 unless the Council approves the reason for the failure to attend before that date.

## **Previous Requests to Council**

8. Members may recall that similar applications to Council have been approved by Council. Each time a request has been approved Council has extended each of the Councillors' periods of non-attendance at meetings by a further six months.

## Options

- 9. Council has the following options :-
  - (a) Do not agree to the request and, unless Councillor Stenson attends a meeting prior to 28 March 2017, he will cease to be a Member of the Council.
  - (b) Agree to the request and, if so, approve the failure to attend by reason of illness and indicate the period for which it will run, before review:-
    - (i) Until he next attends a meeting at the Town Hall; or
    - (ii) Until the reason no longer applies; or
    - (iii) Until Councillor Stenson's term of office has ended (May 2019)
  - (c) Alternatively, a period of six months could be specified with a further review at that time.
