
“Council is opposed to the government’s imposition of real term funding cuts on schools by freezing per-pupil funding while inflation and the cost of employer pension and national insurance contributions increase. This affects all schools and academies alike. Without further funding, schools in the UK will lose £3bn in real terms by 2021.

This Council does not want children in this country to miss out on a decent education, supplied by dedicated teachers and support staff with sufficient resources. Darlington schools could lose up to £6,592,971. That equates to a loss of £492 per pupil and 176 teachers.

Council pledges to work with our two MPs Jenny Chapman MP and Phil Wilson MP, Chairs of Governors, head teachers and parent representatives to speak with a united voice to ensure that all parents of school age children and young people, and the general public, are well informed about the unprecedented dire situation of education funding and the attack on our local democracy.

This Council further pledges to lobby the Government in any way possible, despite the consultation period having formally closed, to ensure that more money is put into our local schools.”
