MAIN REPORT

Information and Analysis

Annual Council

5. Annual Council met on the 20 May 2021 and made decisions to appoint a Mayor and Deputy Mayor, and to appoint Members to Council Committees and to nominate Members to serve on outside bodies.
6. A potential procedural issue has been identified which could lead to the decisions made by Annual Council to be subsequently challenged.
7. While the agenda for Annual Council was sent out the week before the meeting the reports were not ready to be sent out until lunchtime on Thursday 20 May. As we did not comply with the required notice – there is a risk that that decisions made could be challenged because of procedural non-compliance.
8. This is essentially a risk of challenge along the lines that Annual Council was not lawfully competent to make decisions. The main risk is about appointments to Council committees - that the Committees of Council were improperly constituted and that any decisions made by the Committees could be challenged as being invalid on that basis.
9. In order to address this issue, Members are being asked to confirm their approval of the matters decided at Annual Council

11. The political balance on some of the Counting Committees has changed as a result of the by elections that were held on Thursday 6 May 2021.
