Purpose of Report

2. The term of office for the current LA Governor, Councillor Harker, at the Federation of Darlington Nurseries, is due to expire on 31st October 2021. Councillor Harker has indicated his intention to continue as the LA Governor at the Federation of Darlington Nurseries.

3. LA governors are nominated by the local authority but appointed by the governing body. The local authority can nominate any person who is eligible to be a local authority governor, but it is for the governing body to decide whether the nominee has the skills required to contribute to the effective governance and success of the school and meets any other eligibility criteria they have set. Local authorities should therefore make every effort to understand the governing body's requirements and identify and nominate suitable candidates.

Recommendation

4. It is recommended that Members are requested to note the above information and take it into account when nominating to the LA governor position.
