5 ACADEMISATION OF THE MAINTAINED SCHOOLS IN DARLINGTON

The SEND & Inclusion Advisory Lead officer provided information to committee members that all maintained schools Darlington (apart from the Pupil Referral Unit) are now on a track to academisation. Two maintained nurseries are present however the national curriculum does not apply in the early years.

The SEND & Inclusion Advisory Lead officer has been working closely with Rise Carr (PRU) this academic year on planning and delivering Religious Education for which SACRE will be updated once information becomes available.

Discussion was held regarding functions of SACRE in Darlington – members expressed that a useful way forward would be to engage religious representatives from schools alongside the desire to keep faith leaders educated as to the function of SACRE.

A presentation on the function of Jigsaw publication house and its resource portal will be presented to SACRE at a later date.

IT WAS AGREED – That the role of SACRE in Darlington is to be the main agenda item in the next meeting with the clerk to remind members via email prior to meetings to help boost attendance.
