


REASON FOR ITEM/CALL-IN	RESOURCE

To establish how council elected members will have scrutiny and oversight of ~£20m of public money spend. 3. To determine if the current arrangements obviate the democratic process in respect to ~£20M public funding given to DBC. 4. To understand how the decisions, laid out in the agenda, were made and if indeed the current proposal decisions are valid. 5. Why this has been pushed through Cabinet so quickly with no member involvement other than cabinet. 6. How Cabinet satisfied itself that the paper had to be considered at this meeting and not deferred until a future date, given a ward benefiting from the proposals was under purdah rules due a live by-election. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
