SUMMARY REPORT

Purpose of the Report

 To seek Members' views on the report recently presented to Cabinet (attached as Appendix 1), as part of the consultation process on replacing previous Dog Control Orders with Public Space Protection Orders (PSPOs) and the introduction of wider powers concerning the walking and supervision of dogs, and the exclusion of dogs from cemeteries (with some exemptions).
